## Changes to the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets

Traffic, pedestrian and cyclist changes will be implemented at the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets to maintain safe access for the community during the construction of the new underground station. Refer overleaf for details of the changes.

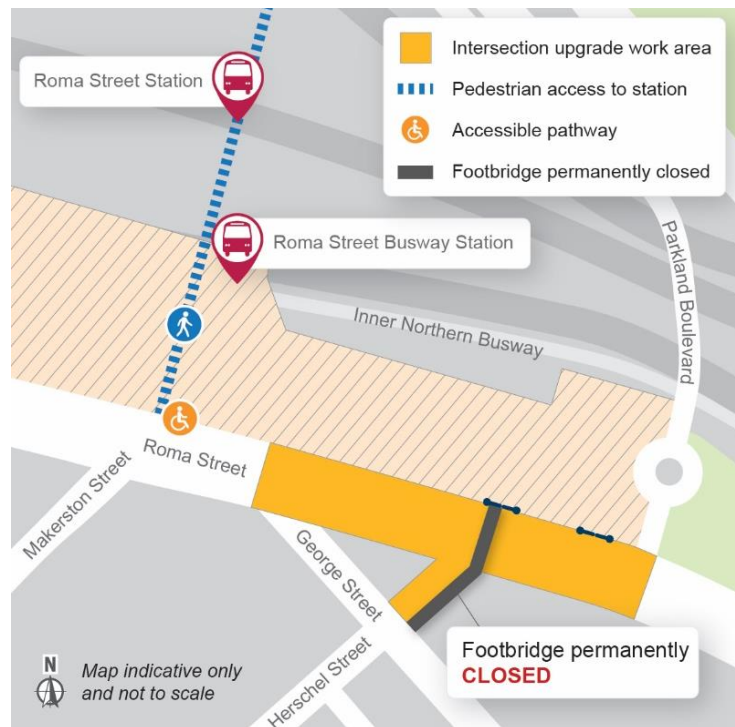
Work to implement the changes will be carried out from **Monday 24 February 2020** and is expected to take **approximately four weeks to complete**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Activities involved include:

- Removing the existing line marking and sections of the kerb and footpaths
- Installing traffic signage, pedestrian fencing and line marking
- Constructing new kerbs and pedestrian ramps
- Modifying the traffic signals to enable the new signalised pedestrian crossing at the intersection.

### Work hours

Due to traffic restrictions and to maintain the safety of the community and our workers, most of the work will be done at night between **6:30pm and 6:30am, Monday to Saturday**. Some works may also occur between **6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**.



## What to expect

During this work, you can expect:

- A potential increase in noise and vibration. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible
- The use of construction equipment such as high pressure water blasting machines, road saws, vacuum excavators, excavators with hammer attachments, jackhammers, concrete trucks, compaction equipment, line marking equipment, hand tools, trucks, survey equipment and traffic control
- Temporary changed traffic conditions and minor traffic delays. Traffic control will be in place where required to maintain the safety of road users, the community and workers.

Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

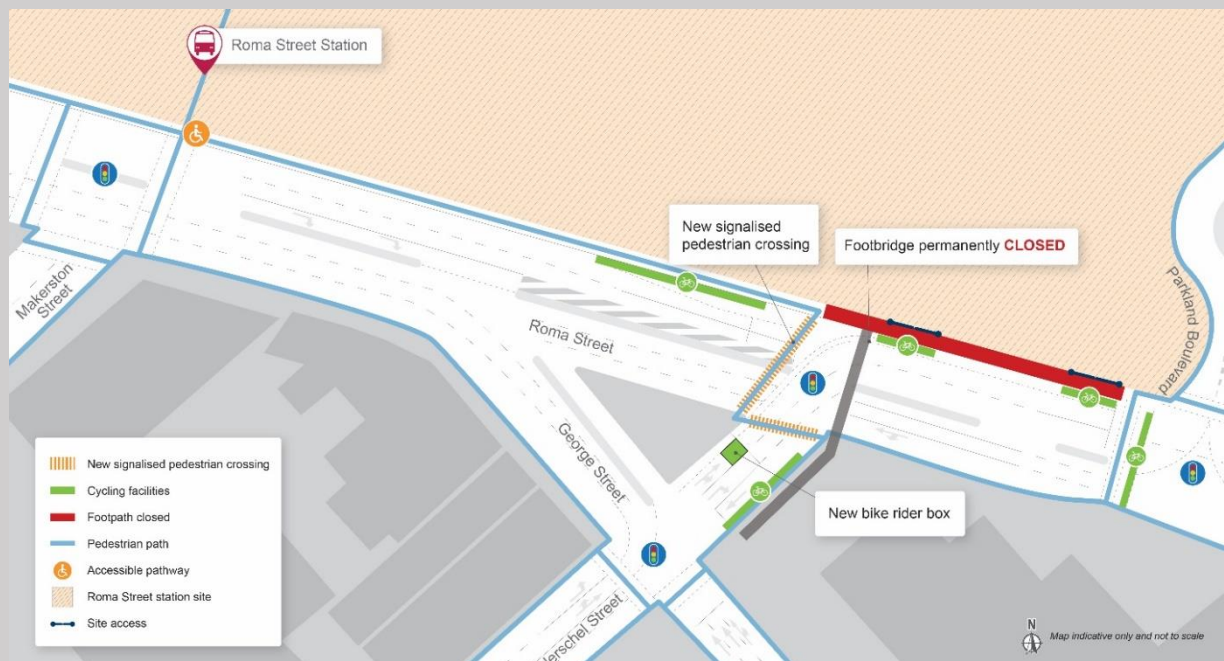
Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the works.

## Future intersection layout at Herschel and Roma streets

Upon completion of the works mentioned overleaf, the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets will be as follows:

- New signalised pedestrian crossings at the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets. This will provide another alternative crossing point during construction activities.
- The inbound cycle lane on Herschel Street between George and Roma streets replaced with a 'bike rider box' at the intersection. This box provides a refuge point for cyclists to wait for the lights to change
- Traffic lanes on Roma Street between George Street and Parkland Boulevard and on Herschel Street between George and Roma Streets will be modified
- The footpath on the northern side of Roma Street between Herschel Street and Parkland Boulevard will be closed. This closure will be implemented once the new signalised pedestrian crossings at the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets are operational.
