Albert Street station construction update

In March 2020, the Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations contractor will start out-of-hours work for site investigations. Meanwhile, demolition, piling and acoustic shed construction will continue, and there will be footpath changes on Mary Street adjacent to the work sites.

Out-of-hours work for site investigations

In March 2020, site investigation work will ramp up across the Albert Street underground cavern alignment. This work will include:

- **Geotechnical investigations**, where a small rig drills up to 60 metres underground to provide ground condition information
- **Service locations and relocations**, where a hydro vacuum unit and a small excavator locate or relocate existing underground services. This work may involve saw cutting
- **CCTV investigations** of existing sewer and stormwater infrastructure, where a hydro vacuum unit cleans out the pipes before a camera is placed inside
- **Installation of survey equipment** into manholes.

Due to traffic permit requirements, this work will be carried out at night or on weekends. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of out-of-hours work.

This work will take place in various locations on the road and footpath along Albert Street between Alice Street and Adelaide Street, and across sections of Margaret Street, Mary Street, Charlotte Street and Elizabeth Street (see map).

During the work, there will be temporary traffic changes around the work area, including lane closures and pedestrian diversions. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians around the changes.



Mary Street lane and footpath closures

Throughout March 2020, there will be intermittent short-term traffic lane and footpath closures on Mary Street alongside Lot 1 and Lot 2. These closures are required to enable the safe removal of scaffolding used for demolition works and delivery of materials onto site.

From late March 2020, for approximately three weeks, the Mary Street footpath will be closed alongside Lot 1. This closure is required to enable piles to be constructed alongside the footpath.

Traffic controllers will facilitate safe pedestrian access across Mary Street. See map over page for more details.

Demolition due for completion

Demolition on Lot 1 (southern side) is due for completion in March 2020. This work involves:

- Safe removal of any hazardous materials found
- 'Hard' machinery demolition of the existing building
- Removing scaffolding
- Removing demolition waste.

Demolition work will continue to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday. This work is expected to be noisy.

Acoustic shed construction

In March 2020, work to construct the acoustic shed on Lot 2 will continue. The acoustic shed is designed to reduce noise from above-ground construction activity. Construction of the shed will include:

- Concrete works to construct the slab (base of the shed)
- Erection of the steel frame of the shed
- Installation of precast concrete panel walls
- Installation of construction support infrastructure, including an electrical substation and water treatment plant.

Site establishment continues

Site establishment activities will continue in March 2020, including installation of site offices and worker facilities.

Some work, including delivery of oversized structures, may be required at night or on weekends due to traffic restrictions. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of out-of-hours work.

Piling continues

Piling on Lot 2 (northern side) will continue in March 2020 and is due for completion in April 2020.

In late March 2020, piling will commence on Lot 1 (southern side) of the Albert Street site and will take approximately two months to complete.


Piling work will occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday. This work is expected to be noisy.

Some work, including delivery and removal of oversized equipment, may be required at night or on weekends due to traffic restrictions. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of out-of-hours work.
