## Woolloongabba station construction update

**Site establishment, piling, excavation, geotechnical and utility identification continues in and around the Woolloongabba station site.**

Throughout March 2020 activities on site will include:

- Continued site establishment and piling works
- Commencement of drilling and anchoring of piles
- Delivery and construction of site office buildings and worker facilities
- General earthwork and excavation activities
- Installation of signage and fencing
- Delivery of machinery and equipment
- CCTV inspections and pressure cleaning of water and sewer infrastructure
- Geotechnical investigations using a truck-mounted drill rig to take samples of ground/soil conditions
- Utility investigation and relocation activities including installing power and other services for tunnelling and site operations
- The use of survey equipment, vacuum excavation trucks, road saws, small excavators, tipper trucks, compactors, and specialist CCTV vehicles.

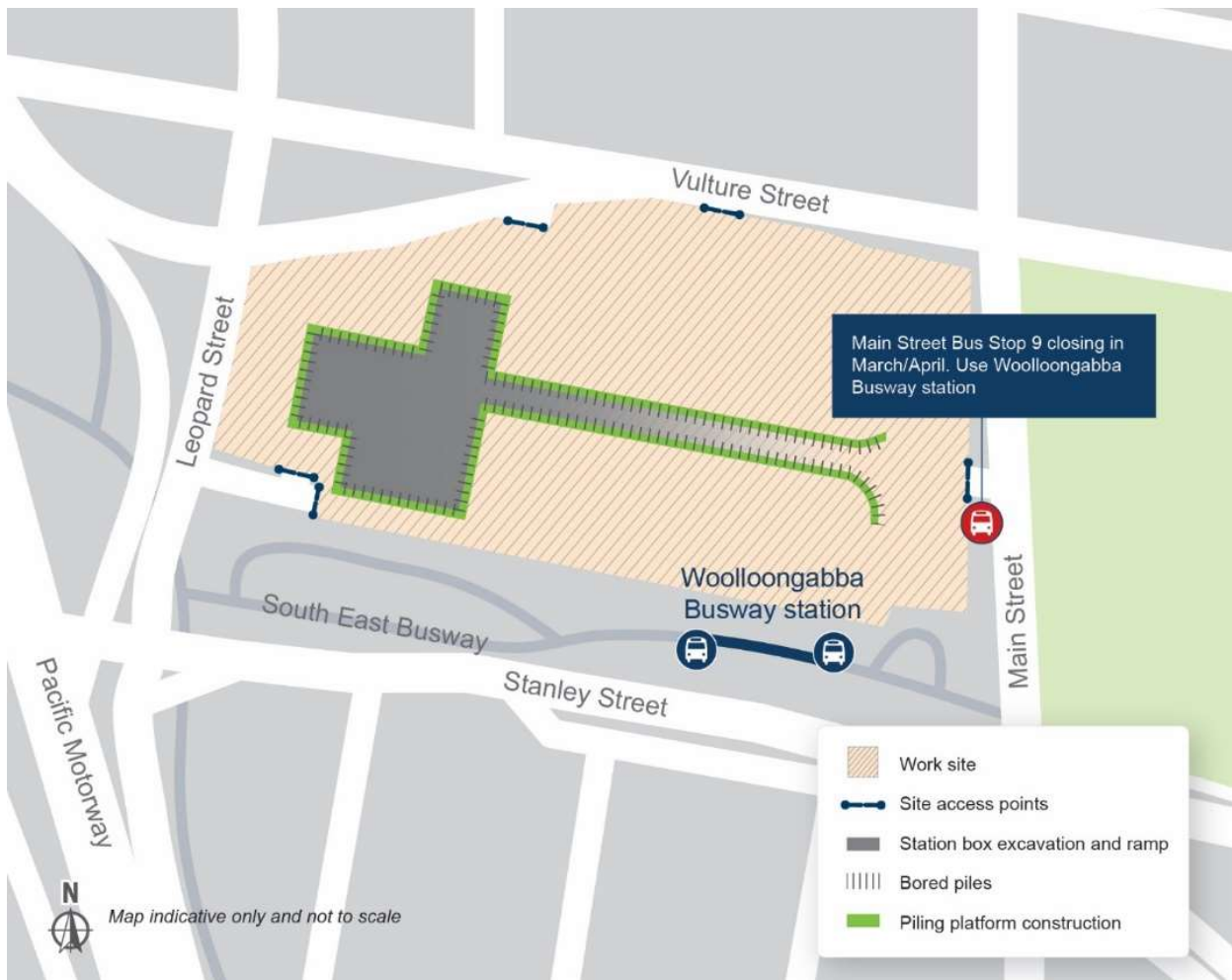
### Bus stop 9 – Main Street

The closure of bus stop 9 on Main Street (The Fiveways) will occur in March/April 2020 to coincide with the establishment of the Main Street site entrance. The closure is required due to the proximity of the site entry and to maintain the safety of the community. Commuters will be able to catch the bus from Platform Two at the Woolloongabba Busway. Signage will be installed at the bus stop in advance of the closure.

### Work hours

Work will generally occur **between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**, weather and construction conditions permitting. However, some work may be required at night due to traffic restrictions and to maintain the safety of the community and our workers. We will notify nearby residents prior to any night work commencing.

Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the work start times to prepare for the shift's activities.



## What to expect

Nearby businesses and residents can expect:

- An increase in construction workers and vehicles in the area
- A potential increase in noise, dust and vibration. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible
- Trucks delivering machinery and materials to the work site
- Temporary changed pedestrian access
- Temporary changed traffic conditions including lane closures.

Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

Every effort will be made to keep disruptions to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.
