## Woolloongabba station construction update

Site establishment, piling, excavation, geotechnical and utility identification continues in and around the Woolloongabba station site.

Throughout April 2020 activities on site will include:

- Piling works
- Drilling and anchoring of piles within the station box
- Construction of site offices and worker facilities
- General earthwork and excavation activities, including haulage of excavated material
- Installation of signage and fencing
- Delivery of machinery and equipment including drill rigs and excavators
- Continued CCTV inspections and pressure cleaning of water and sewer infrastructure
- Geotechnical investigations using a truck-mounted drill rig to take samples of ground/soil conditions
- Utility investigations and relocation activities including installing power and other services for tunnelling and site operations
- Early morning onsite equipment refuelling from 5am
- On site electrical substation work and installation.

### Work hours

Work will generally occur **between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**, weather and construction conditions permitting. However, night works may be required due to traffic restrictions and to maintain the safety of the community and our workers. We will notify nearby residents prior to any planned night works. Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the work start times to prepare for the shift's activities.

### What to expect

- Increased vehicle movements and construction workers in the area
- Increased truck movements as excavation of the station box continues
- Potential increases in noise, dust and vibration. These impacts will be minimised as much as possible
- Trucks delivering and removing machinery and materials to the work site
- Temporary changed pedestrian access
- Temporary changed traffic conditions including lane closures
- The use of survey equipment, vacuum excavation trucks, road saws, small excavators, tipper trucks, compactors, and specialist CCTV vehicles.

Every effort will be made to keep disruptions to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

### Out-of-hours work - Easter weekend

Due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology, work will be undertaken over the Easter long weekend from **Monday to Saturday between 6:30am and 6:30pm**. These include:

- Works associated with station box excavation including, minor earthworks, anchoring and shotcreting.

Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of out-of-hours work.
