Woolloongabba station construction update

Site establishment, excavation, geotechnical and utility identification continues in and around the Woolloongabba station site.

Throughout August 2020, activities on site will include:

- Drilling and anchoring of walls within the station box excavation ongoing
- General earthworks and excavation activities, including offsite haulage of excavated material
- Installation of signage and fencing
- Delivery of machinery and equipment including drill rigs, excavators and tunnelling plant
- Controlled blasting of station box excavation area. As dates are confirmed, advance SMS notification and further information will be provided (see over)
- CCTV inspections and pressure cleaning of water and sewer infrastructure
- Installation of building structural steel for spoil sheds
- Geotechnical investigations using a truck-mounted drill rig to take samples of ground/soil conditions
- Survey monitoring
- Utility investigations and relocation activities including installing power and other services for tunnelling and site operations
- On site electrical substation work and installation
- Construction of reinforced concrete structures
- Concrete deliveries to construct driveways and slabs to seal exposed areas
- Construction of caverns and mined tunnel.

Updated work hours

The Woolloongabba site is now operational 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Out of hours work is required due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology, with works on the site to include (but not limited to):

- Works associated with station box and decline excavation including, earthworks, plant movements, drilling, anchoring and shotcreting
- Over-sized equipment deliveries
- Continued utility investigations and relocation activities.

In the event that out of hours works directly impact local stakeholders (e.g. temporary road closures), you will be notified in advance with specific details.

What to expect

- Potential increases in noise, dust and vibration from construction works. These impacts will be minimised as much as possible, with comprehensive environment and safety management measures in place
- Potential increases in noise and vibration from controlled blasting activities
- The use of survey equipment, vacuum excavation trucks, road saws, small excavators, tipper trucks, compactors, and specialist CCTV vehicles
- Increased vehicle movements and construction workers in the area
- Increased truck movements as excavation of the station box continues
- Trucks delivering and removing machinery and materials to the work site
- Temporary changed pedestrian access
- Temporary changed traffic conditions including lane closures
- Temporary lighting to facilitate out-of-hour works within station box and decline.

Every effort will be made to keep disruptions to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

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Project information

The Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations contractor CBGU D&C JV will deliver the underground tunnel and four new underground stations at Boggo Road, Woolloongabba, Albert Street, Roma Street and an upgrade to the Dutton Park station.

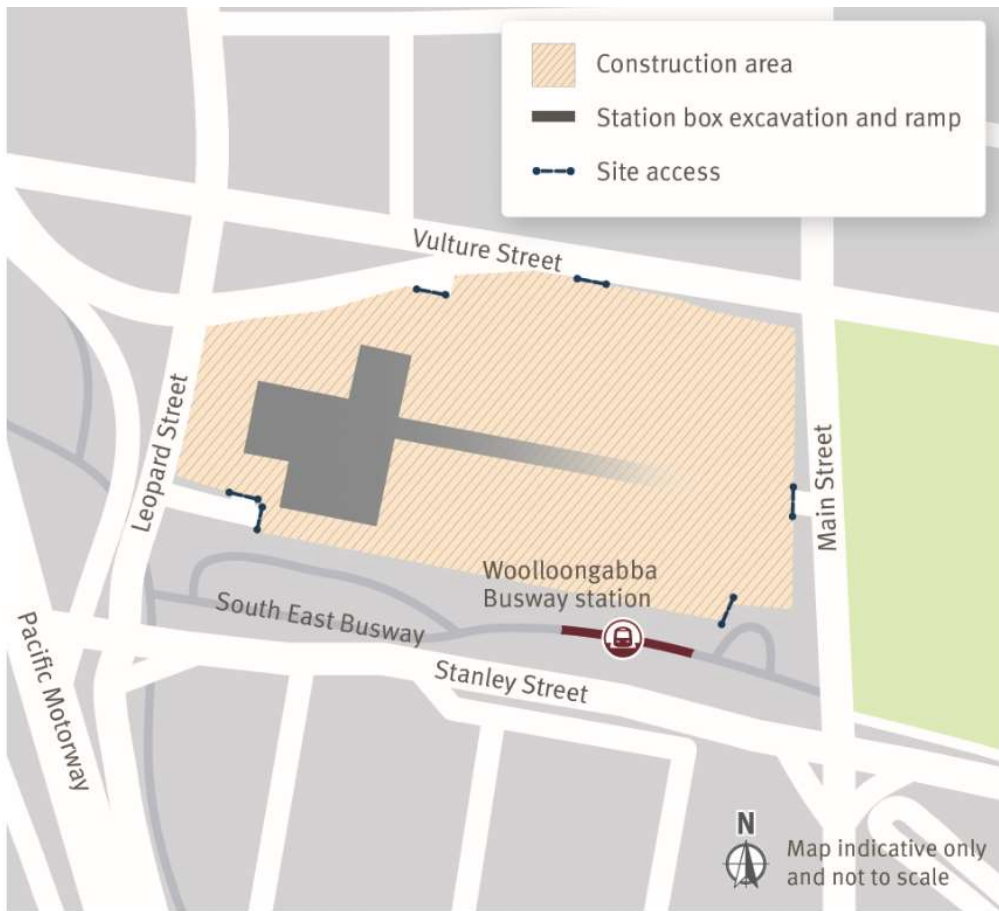


Image 1: Updated Woolloongabba site, showing access points for construction vehicles
