Albert Street station construction update

In August 2020, the Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations contractor will continue major works on the Albert Street station site. On Lot 1, excavation and retention is progressing. On Lot 2, excavation of the tunnel access shaft will continue 24/7 within the acoustic shed. Site establishment and soft demolition of 142 Albert Street (Lot 3) will commence. Out-of-hours work will also continue on local streets in August.

LOT 1 – Main station entrance

Located on the western corner of Albert and Mary Streets

Activity	Timing	Details
Excavation of the main station entrance	June 2020 to mid-2021 6:30am to 10pm, Mon to Sat	 Excavation activities including rock hammering Ground stabilisation and retention (shotcrete, rock anchors, rock bolts and props).
Installation of pedestrian gantry	July to early August 2020 May require out-of- hours work	 Installation of a pedestrian gantry on the Mary Street footpath alongside Lot 1 Short-term footpath closures during lifting activities.

LOT 2 - Tunnelling site

Located on the northern corner of Albert and Mary Streets

Activity	Timing	Details
Excavation of the tunnel access shaft and underground access adits	May to August 2020 24 hours/7 days per week (inside the acoustic shed)	 Excavation activities Controlled blasting (separate notifications to be issued) Delivery and mobilisation of the first roadheader Truck movements Ground stabilisation and retention (shotcrete, rock drilling and rock bolts).
Establishment of tunnelling support infrastructure	Throughout August 2020 May require out-of-hours work	 Finishing works on the acoustic shed Delivery of oversized plant and equipment Delivery and installation of stairs, ventilation, spoil storage bins, etc. Operation of water treatment plant and electrical switchyard.
Footpath closure and construction of new pedestrian crossing	August 2020 to 2022 May require out-of-hours work	 Construction of a temporary pedestrian crossing on Mary Street between The Westin and Quest River Park Central Closure of the Mary Street footpath alongside Lot 2.

LOT 3 – Northern station entrance

Located at 142 Albert Street (near Elizabeth Street). The section of Albert Street between Charlotte and Elizabeth streets is now closed to vehicle traffic, with local/pedestrian access only.

Soft demolition of 142 Albert Street	August to September 2020 6:30am to 6:30pm, Mon to Sat May require out-of-hours work	 Installation of demolition scaffolding Removal of internal fittings/fixtures Hazardous material (HAZMAT) inspections and safe removal Disconnection and removal of existing services.

LOCAL STREETS

Activity	Timing	Details
Utility work on Albert, Mary, Margaret, Charlotte and Elizabeth Streets	Throughout August 2020 Out-of-hours – 6:30pm to 6:30am, Mon to Fri	 Locating, installing or relocating services Lane closures and traffic changes where required.
Geotechnical investigations on Albert Street between Alice Street and Queen Street Mall, including side streets	Throughout August 2020 Out-of-hours – 6:30pm to 6:30am, Mon to Fri	 Drilling boreholes up to 40m deep to understand existing ground conditions Reinstating the borehole with grout.


What to expect

The majority of work will take place between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday, however some work will be required at night or on weekends due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of high impact out-of-hours work.

All work is subject to suitable weather conditions.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect:

- · An increase in truck movements around the project work area
- A potential increase in noise, dust and vibration. We are committed to making every effort to manage and minimise the impacts of construction on the local community
- Temporary traffic changes and minor traffic delays due to lane and footpath closures
