## Construction update Roma Street to Mayne Yard

From October 2020, the UNITY Alliance will continue construction between Roma Street and Mayne Yard as part of the Cross River Rail project.

### Details of work

The activities outlined below are scheduled to occur between Saturday 3 and Monday 5 October 2020, weather and construction conditions permitting. These activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours but are timed to take place within a planned weekend track closure, as outlined below:

### What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, mobile cranes, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light the work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Access to site via Lanham Street and Gregory Terrace
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment

We appreciate your patience during construction and will continue to update you as work progresses.
