## Night works - Normanby rail corridor

Until late December 2020, UNITY Alliance will be required to undertake night works for a number of activities in the Normanby rail corridor between Bowen Bridge Road and College Road, Spring Hill, as part of the Cross River Rail Project.

### Details of work

Work is required to be carried out at night outside standard working hours to complete a number of activities including drainage, earthworks, track maintenance and overhead electrical work. **Night shift works will occur between 6:30pm to 6:30am, Monday to Saturday.**



### These works will involve:

- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the rail corridor via Gregory Terrace and the existing Victoria Park access
- Earthworks and excavation of sections of ground and placement of drainage using heavy machinery such as excavators
- Overhead electrical mast foundation and mast installation
- Cable trenching and installation
- Backfilling and compaction of material
- Removal of redundant structures within the rail corridor
- Lighting towers to light the work area at night.

### What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, mobile cranes, tip trucks, vacuum excavators, water carts and concrete trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light the work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, flashing lights, reverse beepers, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses in proximity to the project site, including:

- Keeping higher noise-generating activities to the earlier stages of night shifts wherever possible
- Ensuring plant / equipment used has been maintained (including noise control devices)
- Minimising light spill by directing light-generating plant and equipment away from residences
- Conducting toolbox talks with work crews to remind them of out of hours work protocols (no unnecessary noise).
