## Construction update Yeronga station

From November 2020, UNITY Alliance will continue work within the rail corridor at Yeronga station for construction of the Cross River Rail project.

### Details of work

The activities outlined below are scheduled to occur between Wednesday 11 to Monday 16 November and Saturday 21 to Monday 23 November 2020, weather and construction conditions permitting. Some of these activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours:

Yeronga station	Intermittently between 2:00am Saturday 14 and 2:00am Monday 16 November 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dual gauge track lowering early works, including geotechnical testing at Yeronga</li> <li>Earthworks and drainage installation</li> <li>Overhead electrical works</li> <li>Water main encasement installation on Dublin Street, Yeronga (day works)</li> <li>Temporary single lane closure adjacent to the rail corridor on Fairfield Road southbound slow lane, and traffic control on Dublin Street, Yeronga. Yeronga station	Intermittently 6:30am to 6:30pm between Monday 16 November and Friday 20 November 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Removal of equipment and reinstatement of Dublin Street water main works area.</li> </ul>
Yeronga station	Intermittently between 2:00am Saturday 21 and 2:00am Monday 23 November 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dual gauge track lowering early works, including geotechnical testing at Yeronga</li> <li>Partial removal of Yeronga station retaining wall and fencing</li> <li>Temporary single lane closure adjacent to the rail corridor on Fairfield Road southbound slow lane, and traffic control on Dublin Street, Yeronga. See map overleaf for pedestrian detours</li> <li>Overhead electrical works</li> <li>Earthworks and drainage installation</li> <li>Water main encasement installation on Dublin Street, Yeronga (contingency day works, if required).</li> </ul>

Signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around works areas. Please observe the directions of traffic control while passing through the area.

## Temporary traffic changes – Fairfield Road southbound slow lane

Temporary closure 6:00am to 7:00pm Saturday 14, Sunday 15, Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 November 2020.



### What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, mobile cranes, elevated work platforms, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Temporary traffic changes and reduced speeds
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.

We appreciate your patience during construction and will continue to update you as work progresses.

**Cross River Rail is Queensland's largest rail infrastructure project. Works are outside of peak times to minimise disruption, so if travelling on weekends, or after 9pm on weeknights, plan your journey at [translink.com.au](https://translink.com.au), or call 13 12 30.**
