## Southern Area traffic changes

During November, local traffic changes will be implemented on Kent Street to enable construction of the Southern Portal and the relocation of sewer and stormwater utilities.

### Kent Street traffic changes

From the week commencing 23 November 2020, changes to the traffic arrangement on Kent Street will be implemented to facilitate access for construction vehicles supporting works in the Southern Portal Area and the relocation of sewer and stormwater utilities. This change will ensure the safety of pedestrians and cyclists using the shared user path. Please see map overleaf, outlining the new traffic arrangements. To ensure the safety of workers and the public, some of this work will be undertaken at night from 6.30pm Friday 27 November until 5.30am Saturday 28 November 2020.

From Monday 30 November, Kent Street will be changed to **one-way only between Cornwall and O'Keefe streets for all vehicles**. The one-way arrangement will provide clear separation between road users and those using the shared user path.

Implementing a one-way traffic arrangement on Kent Street will include the following traffic changes:

- Temporarily extending the existing Kent Street shared user path to Cornwall Street, improving connectivity for cyclists and pedestrians
- Installing a temporary kerb on Kent Street to delineate the extended shared user path
- Changing carpark access on Kent Street to right-in and right-out only
- Removal of old and installing new line marking and traffic signage
- Removal of the taxi zone on the corner of Cornwall and Kent streets near Dutton Park Station. Taxis are to use the loading zone on the other side of Kent Street and Cornwall Street.

Access to Kent Street during the work will remain open to emergency vehicles and local traffic only, as well as road users currently permitted to use the section of road behind the PA Hospital.

### Annerley Road traffic changes

To enable safe access into Kent Street from Annerley Road (inbound), minor adjustments will be made to the traffic island on Annerley Road near Cornwall Street, as shown on the map overleaf. To ensure the safety of workers and the public, **this work will be undertaken at night from 6.30pm Friday 27 November until 5.30am Saturday 28 November 2020**.


### Request for Project Change - update

## What to expect

- Construction activity in the area with potential for an increase in noise, dust, vibration, truck movements and workers.
- Use of construction machinery and equipment including excavators, loaders, trucks, concrete saws, concreting equipment, hand tools, line marking equipment, light vehicles and traffic control.
- Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.
- Changes to traffic and pedestrian conditions on Kent Street, Cornwall Street and Annerley Road.
- Standard construction times are **6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**, however work may occur outside of these hours due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology. Further notification will be distributed in advance of night work.
- Workers may arrive onsite one hour prior to the work start times to prepare for the shift's activities
