Commencement of roadheader tunnelling

Roadheader excavation works on the Cross River Rail tunnels between the Woolloongabba and Boggo Road sites will commence from mid-January 2021.

Tunnelling for Cross River Rail involves:

- Roadheaders tunnelling south from the Woolloongabba underground station to the Boggo Road underground station
- Tunnel Boring Machines (TBM) tunnelling north from Woolloongabba to the Albert Street underground station.

Roadheaders have been working at the Woolloongabba site since mid-2020 to excavate the station caverns. As they complete working in the station caverns in early 2021, the roadheaders will then start mining the two southern tunnels.

During roadheader tunnelling to Boggo Road residents directly above the tunnel alignment may experience some low-level noise and vibration from underground construction works.

You may also notice increased survey works in the local area. Mined tunnel work will be undertaken 24 hours, 7 days a week.

Survey and Monitoring

Throughout the project, surface survey works will be conducted along the tunnel alignment to measure ground water, vibration and subsidence. As part of this, there may be temporary road lane closures, pedestrian detours and other short-term impacts.

The majority of this work will occur within public land, however in the event that monitoring is required within private property the resident will be contacted prior to works being undertaken.
