Construction update Yeronga station

From January 2021, UNITY Alliance will continue work at Yeronga station for construction of the Cross River Rail project.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur in January 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Tree removal on Lake Street, near the Yeronga station entrance. This work will be undertaken from Monday 11 January and will take two day shifts to complete.
- Yeronga station retaining wall removal, within the rail corridor near the Lake Street station entry.
- Continuing water main relocation works between Dublin Street and Fairfield Road. This work will now commence from Monday 11 January and take approximately three weeks to complete. This work will include:
 - Traffic control, local access will be maintained
 - Trenching excavation and pipe installation
 - Manhole reconstruction and road pavement repair works
 - Removal of equipment and reinstatement of work areas.

Some of these activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours (6:30am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday) as outlined below:

Fairfield Road, Yeronga and Dublin Street, Yeronga	Intermittently between 8:00pm and 5:00am Wednesday 13 and Friday 22 January 2021. Up to four night shifts required during this period. See map overleaf for pedestrian detours • Water main connection works on Fairfield Road, Yeronga • Water main connection works on Dublin Street, Yeronga

Signage will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around works areas. Please observe the directions of traffic control while passing through the area.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, vacuum truck, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Temporary traffic changes and reduced speeds
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.
