Changes to the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets

Traffic and pedestrian changes will be implemented at the intersection of Roma and Herschel streets to improve safe access for the community during construction of the new Roma Street station. Refer overleaf for details of the changes.

Work to implement the changes will be carried out in stages from **mid-March 2021** and is expected to take **approximately one week to complete**, weather and site conditions permitting.


Activities include:

- Removing the existing line marking and sections of the kerb and footpath
- Installing traffic signage and line marking
- Constructing new kerbs and pedestrian access ramps
- Modifying the traffic signals to enable the new signalised pedestrian crossing at the intersection.

Work hours

Due to traffic restrictions and to maintain the safety of the community and our workers, most of the work will be done at night between **6:30pm and 6:30am, Monday to Saturday**. Some works may also occur between **6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday**.

Further information about timing of the work will be provided in advance.

What to expect

During this work, you can expect:

- A potential increase in noise and vibration. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible
- The use of construction equipment such as road saws, vacuum excavators, excavators with hammer attachments, jackhammers, concrete equipment, compaction equipment, line marking equipment, hand tools, trucks, survey equipment and traffic control
- Temporary changed traffic conditions. Traffic control will be in place where required to maintain the safety of road users, the community and workers.

Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses, and the community in close proximity to the works.


Future intersection layout at Herschel and Roma streets

Upon completion of the work described overleaf, the intersection of Roma and Herschel Streets will include an additional signalised pedestrian crossing directly between the northern footpath of Roma Street and eastern side of Herschel Street.

The existing signalised pedestrian crossings across Roma and Herschel Streets will remain.

Some adjustments to traffic signalling and phasing will be made at this intersection to allow for the new pedestrian movement.
