

# Works Notice

April 2021

## Construction update

During April 2021, UNITY Alliance will continue work within the rail corridor at Moorooka for construction of the Cross River Rail project. The works are in preparation for new train stabling facilities at Clapham Yard.

As part of the Cross River Rail project additional train stabling, crew facilities, maintenance buildings, fencing and staff car parking will be built at Clapham Yard, adjacent to Moorooka station.

### Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during April 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Constructing temporary site offices
- Placing temporary fencing and erosion and sediment controls
- Ground surface vegetation removal, stripping topsoil and stockpiling materials
- Public utilities identification and relocation (including water, sewer, communications and electrical)
- Geotechnical investigations to determine ground conditions and inform design
- Asbestos removal and redundant buildings and structures to be demolished (refer to map over page) in the project corridor. Prior to demolition, work will be carried out to remove internal fittings and fixtures and to safely remove any hazardous materials found in the buildings. These activities will be carried out in accordance with regulatory requirements for the safety of workers and the community.
- Import, placement and compaction of gravels to build up the ground levels of the stabling yard
- Track and maintenance works within the rail corridor.

### What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Temporary traffic changes on Chale Street, Yeerongpilly. Where required, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists. Please observe traffic signage and directions of traffic controllers
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators, graders, water carts, frontend loaders, mobile cranes, vacuum excavation truck, small power tools, drills, saws and minor vibrating equipment
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.

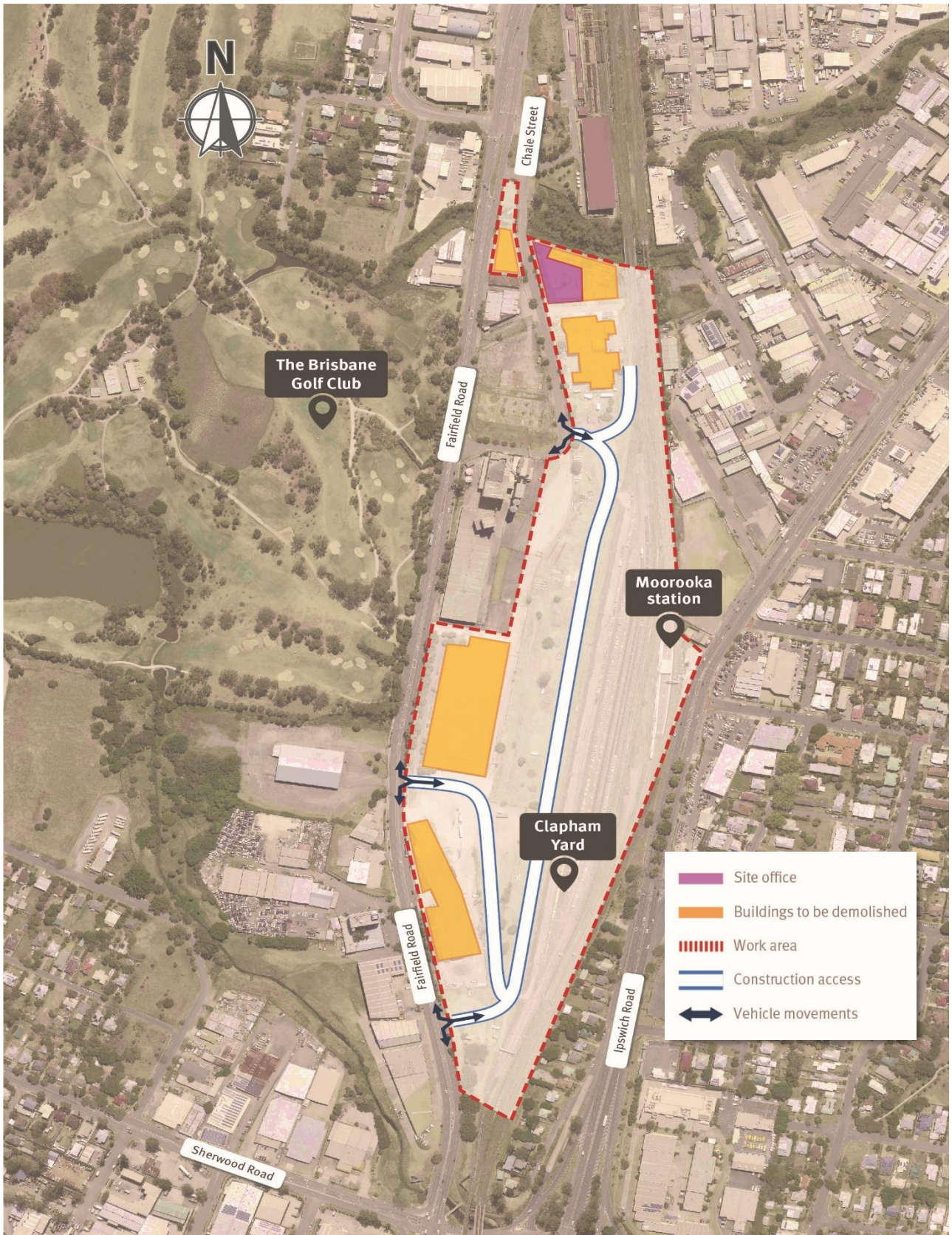
### Moorooka Station and Clapham Yard design

### Out-of-hours work

Some out of hours works will be required during the construction of the new Clapham Yard stabling facilities. We will notify any impacted residents or businesses ahead of any out-of-hours works taking place.
