Roma Street station construction site: Tower crane installation

Weekend work and traffic changes are required to deliver and assemble a 48-meter-tall tower crane for the excavation and construction of the new Roma Street station building.

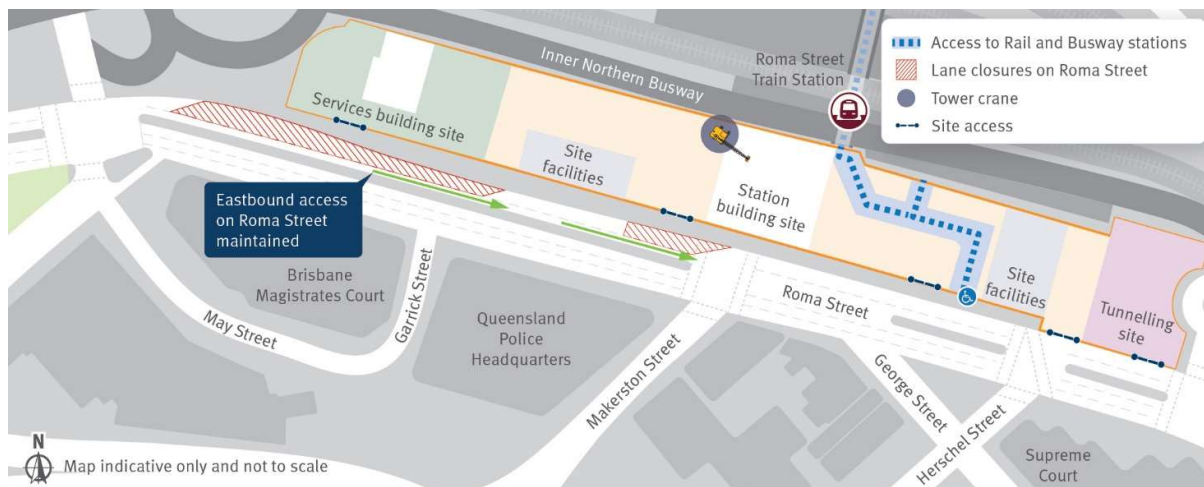
Between **6:30am and 6:30pm on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 June 2021**, temporary partial lane closures are required on Roma Street eastbound, between Countess and Makerston Streets, for delivery and assembly of a tower crane.

Eastbound (inbound) access on Roma Street will be maintained under the direction of traffic control at all times.

Pedestrian access to bus stops and the existing Roma Street rail and bus stations will be maintained. Short pedestrian stoppages and detours on the northern footpath may be required as oversized vehicles enter the construction site.

Work will involve:

- Delivering oversized tower crane components on trucks
- Lifting tower crane components into place using large mobile cranes
- Assembly of the tower crane within the site.



If the installation needs to be rescheduled, it will occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm on Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 June 2021.

What to expect

- Construction activity with potential increased noise, dust, vibration, truck movements and workers. These impacts will be reduced as much as possible.
- Construction impact mitigation activities such as street sweepers and water suppression around the work areas.
- Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes on Roma Street. Please plan your journey and allow additional time if travelling through the area.
- Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.
