Weekend rail corridor works: Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations

The Cross River Rail Tunnel & Stations team will be working in the rail corridor between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations from 2:00am Saturday 19 June until 4:00am Monday 21 June 2021.

Details of work

In late June, works will be undertaken within the rail corridor over a full weekend track closure. These activities will take place 24 hours a day throughout the weekend closure.

Should there be any unexpected weather or ground conditions, these works may be rescheduled.

Dutton Park Station to Park Road and Buranda stations	From 2:00am Saturday 19 June to 4:00am Monday 21 June 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake investigation works and install monitoring equipment • Install stormwater drainage and other utility services • Excavate and concrete to protect piers of existing bridges • Continue constructing railway infrastructure including tracks, overhead lines, and decommissioning, testing and maintaining existing rail signalling • Undertake site investigation works within the rail corridor and at Dutton Park station.


Works to build the new Boggo Road station including tunnel excavation and site operations will also continue to be undertaken during this time.

What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Increased levels of noise and dust in your area
- Construction machinery and equipment being used including piling rigs, excavators, trucks, tamping machine and hand tools
- Increased construction vehicle movements on local roads and within the railway line to deliver concrete, plant, materials and equipment
- Work site and task specific lighting that will be directed away from residential properties
- General construction activities.

Construction vehicles and machinery will enter and exit the rail corridor through Queensland Rail access gates at O'Keefe Street, Kent Street, Martin Street, Harrogate Street and through the Boggo Road work site.
