Construction update Yeronga station

In June 2021, UNITY Alliance demolished Yeronga station buildings and constructed the temporary pedestrian overpass. During July, UNITY Alliance will continue with platform piling, retaining wall construction and commence preparation for demolition of the existing concrete and timber pedestrian overpasses.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday, during July 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continuing platform 1 and 3 retaining wall construction
- Continuing piling on platforms 1 and 2 for platform foundation works
- Identification and relocation of public utilities (water, sewer, communications and electrical)
- Demolition of the Yeronga station timber pedestrian overpass
- Preparation for demolition of the concrete pedestrian overpass. Please note that a separate notice will be provided prior to the remainder of the demolition activities
- Changes to pedestrian access over the rail corridor from early July 2021 (refer to map overleaf). Please note that a separate notice will be provided prior to the opening of the new temporary scaffold overpass
- Track and maintenance work between Yeronga and Fairfield stations.

Out of hours work

The following activities will occur outside the project's normal working hours but are timed to take place within planned weekend track closures, as outlined below:

Location	Date and hours of work	Type of work
Yeronga station	Intermittently between 2:00am Saturday 3 July and 2:00am Monday 5 July 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bored piling on platforms for foundation works • Platform concrete and retaining wall installation works • Installation of platform service conduits and pits.
Yeronga station	Intermittently between 2:00am Saturday 24 July and 2:00am Monday 26 July 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Platform excavation, piling and concrete installation works • Demolition of the Yeronga station timber pedestrian overpass • Crane lifting operations and haulage to remove sections of the overpass from site via Lake Street, under traffic control.

Please note that Yeronga station is now closed as part of an accessibility rebuild. To support customers during the closure, the new 109 StationLink service is now running between Moorooka and Boggo Road stations.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Temporary full road closure on Lake Street 24-26 July 2021, between Killarney Street and Christensen Street during crane operations (refer to map). Access will be maintained to affected Lake Street properties. Traffic control and local road diversions will be in place to assist motorists. Please observe signage
- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, frontend loaders, mobile cranes, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, small power tools, drills, saws, minor vibrating equipment and mobile lighting towers to light work areas at night
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Some noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.
