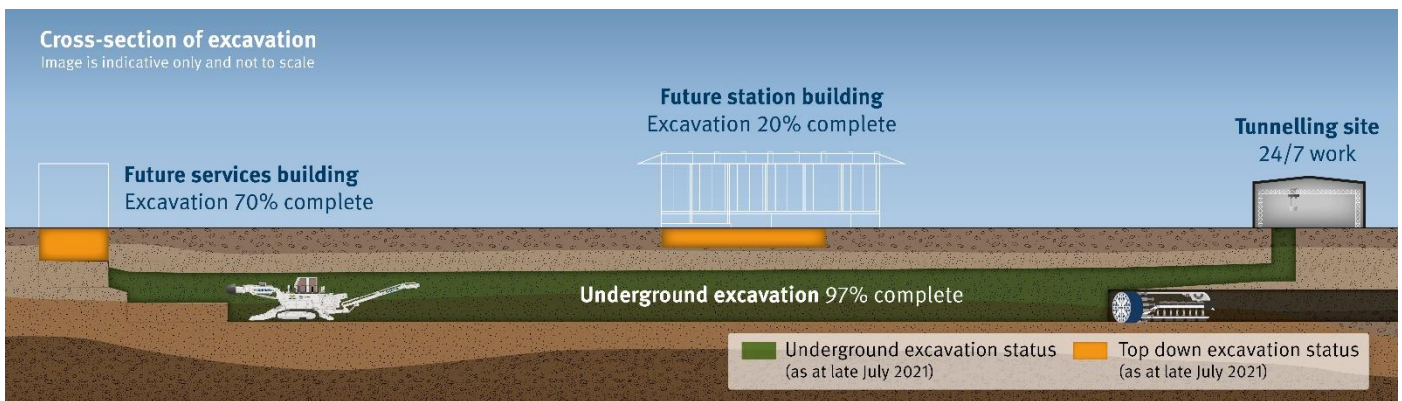

## Roma Street station construction update

All eyes are on the Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) at Roma Street this month with *TBM Else* expected to arrive in early August and *TBM Merle* arriving approximately four weeks later.

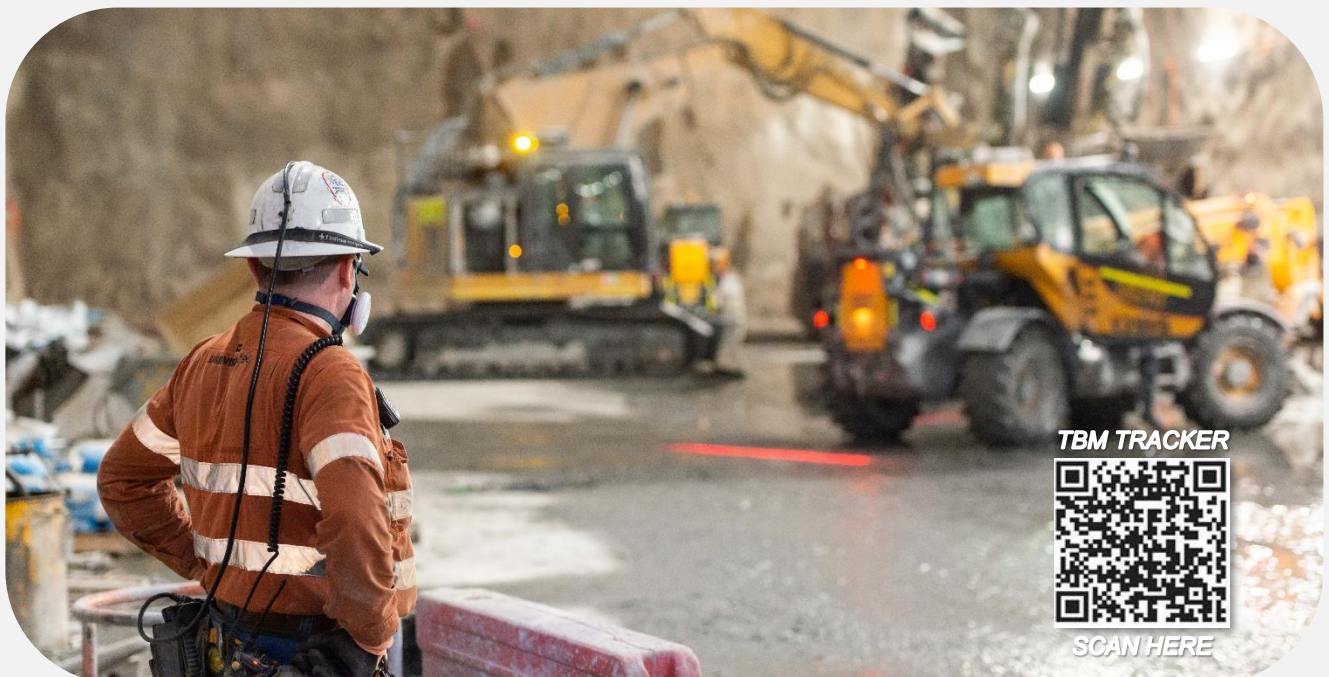
The underground construction team is preparing for their arrival, continuing excavation and installing equipment required to move each of the TBMs through the underground cavern.

Excavation continues above ground at both the service and station building shafts.



### TBMs on their way to Roma Street!

Cross River Rail's TBMs have left Albert Street and are on their way to Roma Street. The first TBM is expected to reach the site in early August. **Scan the QR code to track their journey to Roma Street.**

## Station building site

Opposite Makerston Street



### Excavation and ground support

Ongoing

- Excavating the shaft, installing ground support anchors and shotcrete.
- Loading and removing excavated material with trucks.
- Excavating, concreting and installing micro-piles beneath the Inner Northern Busway.

## Services building site

Opposite Garrick Street



### Excavation and ground support

Ongoing

- Excavating the shaft and progressively installing ground support anchors and shotcrete.
- Loading and removing excavated material with trucks.
- Intermittent controlled blasting within the services building shaft. More information about this work will be distributed separately.

## Tunnelling site

Acoustic shed, corner of Roma Street and Parkland Boulevard



### Underground excavation

Ongoing

- Excavating passenger access tunnels and the station cavern.
- Loading and removing excavated material with trucks.
- Concreting and installing equipment to prepare for arrival of the TBMs.
- Intermittent controlled blasting within the station cavern and adits\*.

## Local streets

Roma Street between Countess Street and Parkland Boulevard



### Services inspection

Ongoing

- Inspecting and relocating underground services around the Roma Street construction site.
- Groundwater monitoring.

## What to expect

- Construction activity with potential for an increase in noise, dust, vibration, truck movements and workers.
- Construction impact mitigation activities such as street sweepers, dust suppression and hoarding installation.
- Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes on Roma Street and surrounding streets.
- Work is subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.

## Work hours



### Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are 6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.



### Out of hours works

Some activities will be completed out of normal construction hours, 6.30pm to 6.30am, due to traffic permits, safety requirements and construction methodology. Nearby residents will be notified in advance via letterbox drop or a poster in the apartment building mail room.



### 24 hours

Tunnelling and tunnelling support activities are undertaken 24 hours a day within the acoustic shed.

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
