



CROSSRIVERRAIL BEENLEIGH AND GOLD COAST LINE TRACK CLOSURE



From Monday 30 August to Sunday 5 September

Cross River Rail will transform the way we travel across the whole of South East Queensland. But building Cross River Rail means changes to travel and transport services during construction.

To carry works out safely, tracks will be closed between Yeerongpilly and Park Road from Monday 30 August to Sunday 5 September.

This means that if you travel on the Beenleigh and Gold Coast lines, your travel will be impacted on both weekdays and weekends.

Changes to your train services

Line	Monday 30 August to Friday 3 September	Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 September
Beenleigh line	Trains will terminate at Yeerongpilly ◀ Buses replace trains between Yeerongpilly and Park Road / Roma Street	Trains run express from Moorooka to Roma Street ◀ Buses replace trains between Moorooka and Roma Street
Gold Coast line	Trains run express from Altandi to Roma Street ◀ Trains will depart four minutes earlier than regular timetable. Plan ahead, leave earlier to avoid missing your regular service	Trains run express from Altandi to Roma Street.

Beenleigh line alternative travel options



StationLink bus route 109 operates every 15 minutes or better between Moorooka and Boggo Road stations

From Boggo Road, transfer to a high frequency bus service like route 66, or a Cleveland line train service from Park Road station.



R586 express bus from Yeerongpilly to Roma Street station

This service will run in the morning and afternoon peaks only.



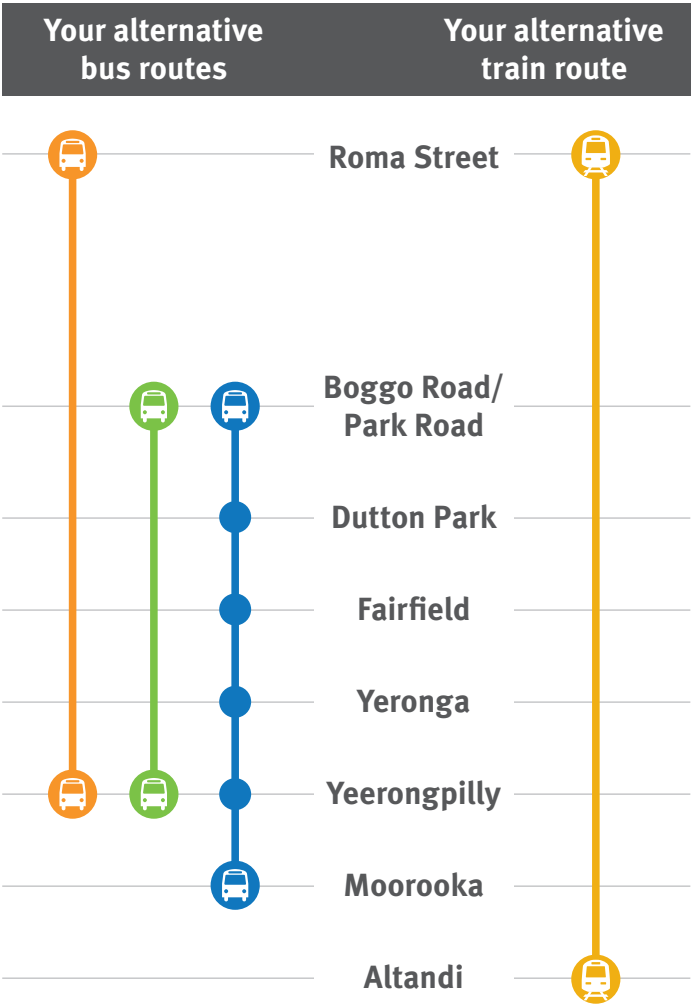
R584 express bus from Yeerongpilly to Boggo Road station

All day service, transfer to a high frequency bus service like route 66, or a Cleveland line train service from Park Road station.



Gold Coast service from Altandi station

It may be quicker to catch a Gold Coast line service. There will be additional Beenleigh services operating from Yeerongpilly to Altandi station. Use TransLink's journey planner to find your quickest connecting train or bus service to Altandi station.



Roads in suburbs along the Beenleigh line such as Fairfield, Annerley or Ipswich Road may be busier than usual to accommodate extra buses servicing closed stations. Plan ahead, and try to reduce travelling by car on these roads where you can to avoid expected delays.
