## Upcoming major rail corridor works

From mid-August 2021, major works are planned within the rail corridor near Peter Doherty Street and Railway Terrace as part of critical Southern Tunnel Portal works.

Works between August to late October 2021 are outlined below, Detailed information about future stages will be provided in the coming months.

Southern Tunnel Portal work is progressing, with piling for the portal foundation more than 50% complete with steelwork and concreting continuing. Most of these activities occur within the worksite along Kent Street

On the other side of the rail corridor, near Peter Doherty Street, building the portal will involve removing existing rail track, installing foundations, excavating and rebuilding new rail track. These works will be broken into multiple stages as outlined below, including an initial weekend track closure between 14-15 August and then two stages from August to October 2021. Information about construction activities scheduled to occur between November 2021 and March 2022 will be provided in a separate notification.

### Details of work

#### Weekend rail corridor works: Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations

A weekend closure of the rail corridor is required between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations from **2am Saturday 14 August** until **4am Monday 16 August**. Construction activities will include:

- Removal of existing railway infrastructure in preparation for major works commencing in late August
- Earthworks and installation of stormwater drainage
- Service investigations and installation.

Works are scheduled **24 hours** for the duration of weekend closure and may generate increased levels of noise

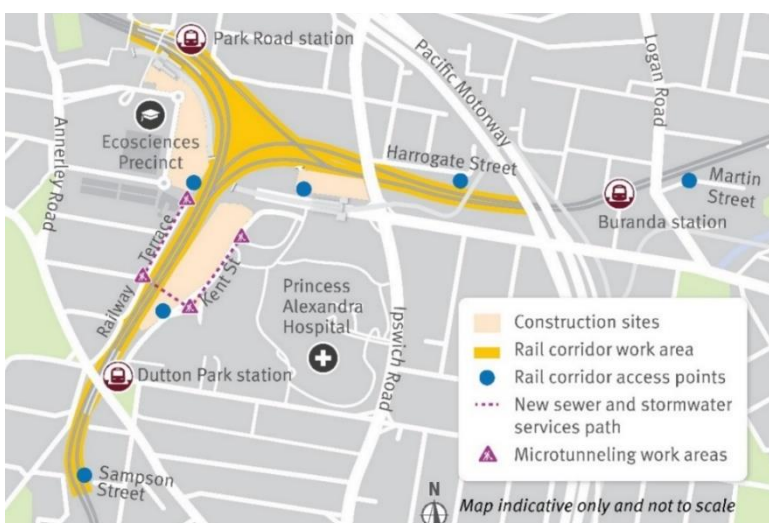


Figure 1: Rail corridor works area

Works within the site and rail corridor will then continue **24 hours a day from 16 to 30 August 2021** to focus on piling platform preparation works. This will include the use of excavators, rollers and increased trucks movements in the area.

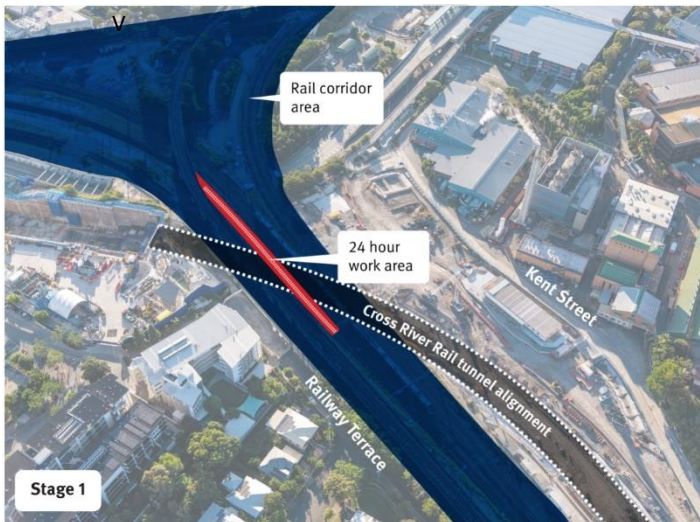
Cross River Rail would like to speak to you about upcoming major works within the rail corridor.

Due to the Queensland Government lockdown for South East Queensland, doorknocking for upcoming works has been cancelled.

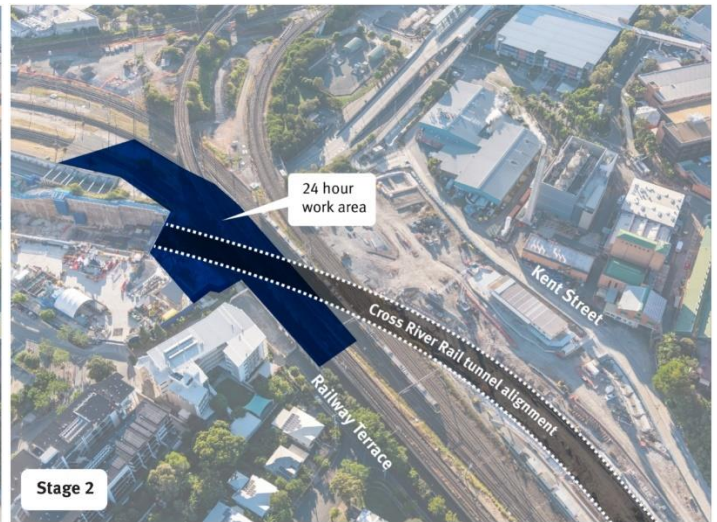
Cross River Rail will now host a **live webinar at midday on Monday 16 August** to discuss these works with local residents.

## Stage 1: Extended 24 hour rail corridor works

From Monday **30 August 2021** for approximately one week, an intensive period of work will take place to strengthen the base of existing train lines to continue construction of the Southern Tunnel Portal underneath.

Construction activities outlined below will take place **24 hours/7 days** and are within close proximity to Railway Terrace. Works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise and include:

- Removing existing rail infrastructure and ground preparation works
- Piling and jack hammering
- Installing steel and concreting
- Transporting materials to and from the worksite
- Commence construction of railway infrastructure.

Additional rail corridor works between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations (see figure 1) are also scheduled during this time and include:

- Stormwater drainage
- Maintenance and construction of rail infrastructure
- Bridge pier protection works.

## Stage 2: Building the foundation

Stage 2 will start close to Railway Terrace to rebuild the new train tracks and continue building the foundation for the tunnel portal entrance.

Stage 2 works will take place **24 hours/7 days** from **early September to late October 2021**, with high impact activities planned during standard construction hours (6:30am to 6:30pm), where possible. Impacts are expected to reduce compared to Stage 1 and will include:

- Piling and jack hammering
- Earthworks
- Transporting materials to and from the worksite
- Installing steel and concreting.

Weekend rail corridor works between Dutton Park, Park Road and Buranda stations (see figure 1) are scheduled from **2am Saturday 9 October until 4am Monday 11 October**. Activities during this time will include construction of railway infrastructure, pier protection and drainage works.

Should there be any unexpected ground conditions, the timing of medium to high impact works may be scheduled to take place outside of standard construction hours. We will be in contact with nearby residents if extended or out-of-hours works are required.
