Albert Street station construction update

In September, the work cycle for the new underground station (Lot 1) will commence with drill reset in preparation for controlled blasting, then move back to excavation and retention in mid-September.

Tunnelling and support activities will continue from within the acoustic spoil shed (Lot 2). Excavation, retention and load out of material with crane use is ongoing at the northern entrance site (Lot 3) and will involve intermittent pedestrian holds.

- Drilling (Early Sept)

- Controlled blasting.
- Site facilities adjustments.

Progress is indicative and subject to conditions permitting.

Lot 2 *Tunnelling and support activities within the acoustic spoil shed*

- Excavation using roadheader, rock hammer and controlled blasting.
- Permanent lining work in adits including waterproofing, reinforcement, installing formwork and concrete pumping.
- Ventilation and tunnel services adjustments.
- Underground retention including rock bolting and shotcreting.
- Installing formwork, steel fixing and concreting activities underground.
- Spoil removal.

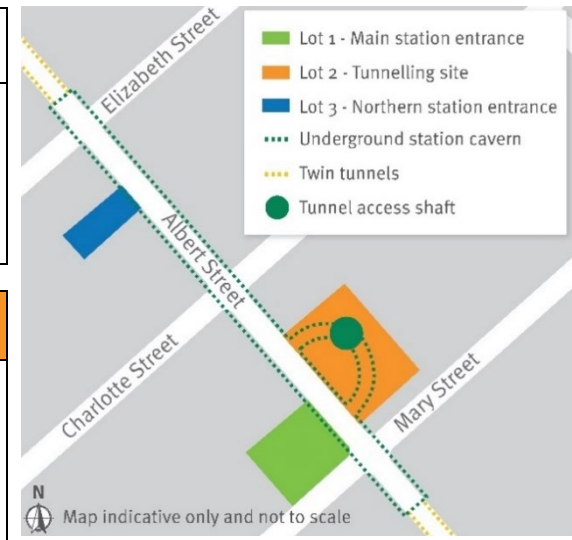
Lot 3

- Excavation and retention including rock hammering, drilling, anchoring and shotcreting.
- Installing formwork, steel fixing and concreting activities.
- Geotechnical investigations.
- Spoil removal using tower crane.
- Site facilities and gantry adjustments.
- Installing and maintaining services.

Local streets *Albert Street between Alice and Queen streets: Elizabeth, Charlotte and Mary streets*



- Installing and maintaining monitoring equipment and services.
- Utility, borehole and geotechnical investigations.
- Underground controlled blasting near Alice Street.
- Vegetation maintenance.



What to expect

An increase in:

- Dust
- Noise
- Vibration
- Truck and construction vehicle movements.

For your safety, intermittent temporary pedestrian holds and diversions will be in place near the worksites.

Monday to Saturday.
