Construction update Fairfield station

During August 2021, UNITY Alliance undertook track lowering preparation works including electrical overhead line mast foundation installations, service under bore works and embankment stabilisation works at Fairfield station. During September 2021, UNITY Alliance will continue construction activities at Fairfield station for construction of the Cross River Rail project.

Details of work

The following activities are scheduled to occur between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday during September 2021, weather and construction conditions permitting:

- Continue track lowering preparation works within the rail corridor including station and site inspections
- General station and track investigations including survey and locating services.

What to expect

During these works you may notice some intermittent disruptions such as:

- Light vehicles, trucks and machinery including excavators with hydraulic hammers, loaders, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, concrete trucks, drilling rig, saws, small power tools, minor vibrating equipment
- Changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel
- Increased noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery and equipment
- Placement of temporary fencing around construction areas.
