16 Day Wonders of Peru

Day 1 New Zealand - Lima, Peru

Today depart from either Auckland, *Wellington or *Christchurch to Lima, Peru via Santiago, Chile. Fly with LATAM Airlines, Qantas Airways, Air New Zealand or United Airlines (subject to availability). Upon arrival into Lima, a representative will be waiting to transfer you to the hotel in Miraflores.

Overnight: Casa Andina Classic Miraflores Centro or similar, Lima

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Lima City Tour

After breakfast enjoy a city tour taking in the key sites of Lima. See Huaca Pucllana, colonial buildings such as the Plaza Mayor, the Government Palace and the Central Bank Museum. Afterwards return to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Casa Andina Classic Miraflores Centro or similar, Lima

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 3 Lima - Cusco

This morning you will be picked up from the hotel and be transferred to the airport for the flight to Cusco. Be met upon arrival at Cusco Airport and be transferred to the hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to explore this beautiful city at your own pace.

Afterwards, travel to the archaeological complex of Saqsayhuaman. You will then see the labyrinth of Q'enqo which is a religious centre dedicated to the adoration of the Earth, and Puca Pucara (reddish place) that was previously used as a military control centre. Complete the tour at Tambomachay (Temple of the Water) an Inca site consisting of a series of aqueducts, canals and waterfalls (entrance not included). Afterwards you will be transferred back to the hotel for the evening at leisure.

Overnight: Ramada Costa Del Sol or similar, Cusco

Day 5 Cusco - Sacred Valley Tour - Urubamba

This morning you will travel from Cusco, past Saqsayhuaman over the mountains towards the Sacred Valley. Here you will descend 1500 feet to the valley floor, and find yourselves by the sacred Urubamba River and the village of Pisac (approx. 1 hour). In Pisac, enjoy a quick visit to a traditional artisan market, where you can browse and buy some local souvenirs if desired.

Afterwards, drive to the ruins of Pisac where you can explore the extensive ruins whilst enjoying stunning views over the valley. Here you will be given a guided tour of the Citadel of Pisac, in which you will see the ruins of temples, homes, altars, carvings, tunnels, caves and the famous Intihuatana, which translates to "the hitching post of the sun". Intihuatana, the place where the sun gets tied, is a religious construction and used like a clock to measure when it was time to celebrate the winter solstice, one of the most important celebrations and rituals of the entire ancient Incan empire.

For those who would prefer to spend more time in the market instead of visiting the ruins, please advise your guide so they can organize a time and place to collect you when returning





past the market. Afterwards continue onwards to Urubamba (approx. 1 hour), where you will make a stop for lunch (not included). A short drive onwards is Ollantaytambo, which is surrounded by the sacred mountains. Here, you will enjoy further exposure to Incan constructions, mainly the amazing temple of the sun, enormous blocks of rock perfectly carved, stone water fountains, stairs and terraces. Upon arrival at the bus station in Puno, you will be met and transferred to the hotel where you will meet your guide who will welcome you and provide you with some extra information for the following days activities.

The islands have been created entirely with the buoyant totora reeds that grow abundantly in the shallows of the lake. Partially edible (tasting like non sweet sugarcane), the reeds are also used to build homes, boats and handicrafts. The islands are constructed from many layers of the totora, which are constantly replenished from the top as they rot from the bottom, so the ground is always soft and springy. You will visit two different islands and your guide will explain a little about the history and lifestyle of the people who have lived here for many years. You will have the opportunity to visit some of their homes to learn a little about their lifestyle.

Afterwards sail to Taquile Island (approx. 2 hours). A traditional Quechua speaking community, full of ancient agricultural terraces and some ruins dating back to pre-Inca times. The Taquile population was relatively isolated from the mainland until the 1950s and the importance of community and family is still very strong. When you reach the island, take the opportunity to enjoy the impressive views of Lake Titicaca. Enjoy some free time to explore the island on your own and afterwards come together for lunch at a local restaurant.

After lunch, head down to the harbour to take a one-hour boat ride to the Chicuito Peninsula, south of the city of Puno, where the Luquina Karina community is located. Luquina Karina has remained relatively untouched and tourism is a new concept here. The inhabitants are very willing to receive visitors in their community and you will be warmly received by the families who will take you into their homes to spend the night and cook you a delicious dinner from locally sourced food.





While enjoying your first taste of the jungle, pack only the necessary gear for your next few days, and leave the rest in a provided safe deposit. Skirting Puerto Maldonado, drive 20 kilometres to the Tambopata River Port, entering the native community of Infierno. Shortly after take a 2.5 hour boat ride from the Tambopata Port to Refugio Amazonas, this will travel past the Community of Infierno and the Tambopata National Reserve's checkpoint and into the buffer zone of this 1.3 million hectare conservation unit.

Upon arrival at the lodge you will be welcomed with an orientation and shown to your room. Enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure in this beautiful jungle environment. Take the opportunity at night to travel the river's edge, scanning the shores with headlamps and flashlights to catch the red gleams of reflection in the eyes of caiman (small crocodile-like reptiles).

activity (included), or enjoy a free day at leisure soaking up the jungle environment.

Oxbow lakes are an important and distinct habitat found in the Amazon basin. Formed when a bend in an Amazonian river gets cut off from its main channel, their waters are much calmer and clearer than the silty, turbulent river. Shallow and tranquil, Oxbow lakes provide the perfect habitat for marsh grasses and a host of interesting animals that prefer these backwater lagoons. Many of these animals are also easy to watch and thus make great photography subjects. Paddle around the lake on a canoe or a catamaran, looking for lakeside wildlife such as hoatzin, caiman and horned screamers. Macaws may also be seen flying overhead.

After looking for rainforest wildlife that lives in the water and forests next to the lake, your guide will take you to back to the lodge by way of a hike on a well conserved rainforest trail.

Day 15 Parrot and Peccary Clay Lick

This morning after breakfast you may take part in an optional activity (included), or enjoy a free day at leisure soaking up the jungle environment.

A 15 minute boat ride and a 60 minute walk from Refugio Amazonas is a clay lick used both by parrots and parakeets. With a little bit of luck, spot mealy and yellow-crowned amazons, blue-headed Pionus, severe macaw and orangecheeled (Barraband's) parrot. A few minutes hike from the lodge is a beautiful growth patch of Brazil Nut forest that has been harvested for decades. See a demonstration of the harvesting process. Further along is the peccary clay lick, an area of exposed clay where animals such as birds and wild rainforest pigs gather to lick or eat the clay. Take the chance to spot pigs, along with deer, guan or parakeets. Have the option of hiking out in the evening, when most of the mammals are active but difficult to see.

Overnight: Refugio Amazonas Lodge or Posada Amazonas Lodge, Tambopata National Reserve
Meals included: Breakfast;Lunch;Dinner

Day 16 Puerto Maldonado - Lima

After breakfast, retrace the river and road back to Puerto Maldonado, and then onwards to the airport for the flight back to Lima. Upon arrival into Lima Airport you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

Day 17 Lima Free Day

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or

commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Lima:

Lima is usually described as mild and warm throughout the year without noteworthy rain making Lima one of the driest capitals in the world. The average temperatures range from 18°C to 28°C.

Cusco:

Cusco has a subtropical highland climate due to its elevation (3500m above sea level). It is generally dry and temperate, with two defined seasons. The dry season lasts from May to August, with abundant sunshine and occasional night time freezes; July is the coldest month with an average of 9.7 °C. The wet season lasts from December to March, with night frost less common; November averages 13.3 °C. Although frost and hail are common, the only snowfall ever recorded was in June 1911. Temperatures usually range from 0.2°C to 20.9 °C.

Puno:

As Puno is located at such a high elevation (3830m above sea level), it experiences more extreme weather conditions than would be expected for its tropical latitude. The average annual temperature is about 8.4°C, and the weather never gets overly warm. During the winter months from June to August, night-time temperatures usually drop well below 0°C. At this high altitude, the rays of the sun are very strong. Most of the annual precipitation falls during the southern hemisphere summer, with the winter months being very dry.
