Day 1 Australia – Istanbul, Turkey

Today depart from Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth for Istanbul, Turkey! Fly with award winning airlines such as Emirates, Etihad Airways, Singapore Airlines or Cathay Pacific to name a few (subject to availability).

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Welcome to Istanbul

Upon arrival you will be transferred to the hotel. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel.

Overnight: Ramada Plaza Istanbul City Centre / Golden Horn Hotel or similar, Istanbul

Meals included: Dinner

Day 3 Istanbul City Tour

This morning after breakfast you will be picked up from the hotel for a day tour of old Istanbul city. Visit Topkapi Palace, the great palace of Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centuries housing an exquisite collection of crystal, silver and Chinese porcelain. Also robes worn by the sultans and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury, miniatures, the Holy Mantle and enshrining relics of the Prophet Mohammed. Next you will see Sultan Ahmet Imperial Mosque, built in the 16th century by the architect Mehmet, it's known as the Blue Mosque because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. A

fterwards you will see the Ancient Hippodrome, the scene of chariot races, with the three monuments; the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine. After lunch you will visit the Spice Bazaar (Egyptian Bazaar). The air here is filled with the enticing aromas of cinnamon, caraway, saffron, mint, thyme and every other conceivable herb and spice. This evening you can take the opportunity to join an optional evening cruise (not included).

Optional activity: Bosphorus Dinner Cruise - \$80 AUD

jewellery, stones and silver so today you will enjoy a stop at a jewellery centre. Arrive in Kusadasi this evening around 6:00pm in time for dinner.

Overnight: Charisma De Luxe Hotel or similar, Kusadasi

Day 7 Ephesus Tour & Sirince Tour

Today enjoy a guided tour of Ephesus. One of the best preserved ancient sites in the world, visit the Temple of Artemis, Curetes Street, Roman baths, Celsus Library, Grand Theatre and the House of the Virgin Mary. After lunch, visit a place which continues to perform one of the oldest arts of Turkey; a carpet weaving centre.

Afterwards enjoy a tour of the Turkish village of Sirince. A pretty village that mostly dates back to the 19th century with original white painted houses. Sirince also has a fantastic reputation for making some of the best wines in Turkey - especially fruit wines. Visit a vineyard and learn how to make fruit wine with Turkish wine makers. On the way back to the hotel visit one of the famous leather production centres of the region.

Once a sprawling modern Roman town, then a Byzantine Empire, then Seljuks and finally an Ottoman Turkish town. See the Marina, Clock Tower, Hadrian Gate, Broken Minaret and Hidirlik Tower. The Hadrian Gate (or Hadrianus Gate or The Three Gates) is a triumphal arch which was built in the name of the Roman emperor Hadrian. The Broken Minaret of the Korkut Mosque was built originally as a Roman temple in the 2nd century AD and did not have a minaret. Hidirlik Tower is a landmark tower of tawny stone. It's believed to have been built in the Hellenistic era on a square plan and then later turned into circular tower in 2nd century AD and was either used as a fortification or a lighthouse. After lunch, depart for Duden Waterfalls. After the tour the rest of day is yours to either explore or relax. Tonight enjoy dinner at the hotel with unlimited spirits and soft drinks. (Please note: the unlimited spirits and soft drinks are available on November 2018 to March 2019 dates only).

Dervishes! Afterwards drive to Cappadocia and check-in to the hotel.

Overnight: Gamirasu Luxury Cave Hotel or similar, Cappadocia
Meals included: Breakfast;Lunch;Dinner

Day 12 Cappadocia Tour

Early this morning why not take the opportunity to join an amazing optional experience – Hot Air Ballooning (not included). Today enjoy a tour of the Cappadocia area. Drive to Ozkonak Underground City, one of the best preserved underground cities in Cappadocia, then visit Uchisar Castle, the highest point of Cappadocia. Next you will visit Goreme Open Air Museum, the heart of Cappadocia and famous for frescoes dating back to the 10th century which describe the life of Jesus Christ and monks.

After lunch, visit a pottery work shop and see how pottery is made. Then visit Pasabagi where you can see three headed fairy chimneys. Afterwards visit another workshop to see Cappadocian handwoven carpets and kilims. Next stop is Devrent Valley, also called Imagination Valley, where you can see natural rock formations. Then you will have some time for shopping at a Handicrafts centre. The last stop is the Three Beauties, three beautiful fairy chimneys with their hats, which is the symbol of Cappadocia. After the tour transfer back to hotel.

Take in the breathtaking landscape home to magnificent valleys, volcanic rock formations, spectacular pigeon houses and a view that will be unforgettable. 

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Istanbul

Temperatures in May/June and September/October are between 22 and 30°C. January/December has an average temperature of around 15°C.

Cappadocia

Cappadocia has a continental climate characterised by dry summers and sometimes snowy winters. Rainfall is sparse and the region is largely semi-arid to arid. There is a sharp difference in the temperature between day and night and it is not uncommon to have cold nights interspersed with hot days.

Kusadasi

There are two main seasons in Kusadasi: the cold season and hot season, which basically correlate with winter and summer in other parts of Europe. The shoulder seasons, autumn and spring, experience weather patterns that are a mix of both the cold and warm seasons.

Antalya

July is the hottest month in Antalya with an average temperature of 28°C and the coldest is January at 10°C with the most daily sunshine hours at 13 in July.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the Airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. Meals:

VISAS

A tourist visa is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian Passport. You will be able to start your eVisa application process once you receive your final travel documentation 6 weeks prior to departure.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such a journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.
