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THE ITINERARY

Day 1 Australia – Los Angeles/San Francisco/Vancouver - Calgary, Canada

Today depart from Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, *Adelaide or *Perth for Calgary! Fly with Air Canada, Delta Airlines, United Airlines or American Airlines to name a few (subject to availability). Upon arrival please make your own way to the hotel for check-in. Check-in is from 3pm onwards and luggage storage will be available for any passengers with an early arrival.

Overnight: Ramada Plaza Calgary Airport or similar, Calgary, Alberta

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2 Calgary – Lake Louise – Canmore

This morning enjoy the breathtaking scenery as you drive into the Rocky Mountains towards Banff National Park (approx. 2 hours). The incredible glaciers, dramatic peaks and brilliant emerald waters of Lake Louise and Moraine Lake have wowed visitors since the 1890s. Experience the birthplace of Canadian mountaineering today. You will visit the “Jewel of the Canadian Rockies”, Lake Louise, and the world-renowned Moraine Lake, both of which are part of a UNESCO world heritage site. You will have enough time to take some souvenir photos at both lakes and walk to the Rockpile, a spectacular viewpoint at Moraine Lake. Story telling abounds on this trip as you learn of the mountaineering history and local legends of the area. Afterwards drive onwards to the town of Canmore to check-in to your accommodation and enjoy an evening at leisure.

Please note: Moraine Lake visit is subject to weather conditions. If Moraine lake is not visited, an extended visit to Lake Louise will take place.

Day 3 Canmore – Icefields Parkway - Columbia Icefield – Golden

This morning drive along the famous Icefields Parkway (Highway 93) and Jasper National Parks from Canmore north

towards the Columbia Icefield Discovery Centre (approx. 2.5 hours each way). Considered the most beautiful drive in the world, the jaw-dropping scenery is punctuated by more than 100 ancient glaciers, waterfalls cascading from dramatic rock peaks and turquoise lakes set in sweeping valleys. Views of Crowfoot Glacier, Bow Summit and Mistaya Canyon are sure to please all who journey to this amazing part of the world. Upon arrival at the Columbia Icefield Discovery Centre take an opportunity to ride on the specially designed “Ice Explorer” (not included) which takes you onto the surface of the stunning Columbia Glacier. In the afternoon drive onwards to the town of Golden (approx. 2.5 hours distance).

Overnight: Travelodge or similar, Golden

Day 4 Golden – Abbotsford

This morning journey through three of Canada’s most breathtaking National Parks: Mount Revelstoke, Glacier and Yoho. On the way stop at Eagle Pass and visit the “Last Spike” of the transcontinental railway where it connects the east to the west. Continue onwards to the town of Abbotsford outside of Vancouver where you will check into your accommodation and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure. Please note this day will involve approximately 8 hours of travel, including rest stops along the way. Fortunately, you will be blessed with amazing sights, including huge snow-capped mountains and beautiful tree-lined lakes.

Day 5 Abbotsford – Vancouver Sightseeing – Begin 7 Night Alaska Inside Passage & Hubbard Glacier Cruise



Day 6 Inside Passage Cruising

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as you sail through the islands of Alaska's Inside Passage. Home to diverse wildlife - orca, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters and more, the complex labyrinth of fjords and bays are where whales and sea lions find refuge during the summer months. You'll never forget the sight of 40-ton whales hurling themselves into the air, almost completely escaping the water. If you're especially lucky, you could see them swimming together to create a bubble net, trapping and eating fish by the giant mouthful.

Day 7 Icy Strait Point, Alaska - 3.30pm to 10:00pm

For thousands of years, the Tlingit Indians have called this place home. Located near the city of Hoonah, and home to a historic cannery, Icy Strait Point also offers travellers the chance to view wildlife like humpback whales, orcas, seals, eagles, and brown bears, or to explore monuments to the region's fishing heritage.

part of Juneau's Icefield, 1500 square miles of ice feeding 38 glaciers.

Known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World', Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit people, who have carved the world's largest collection of totem poles. If you're up for an adventure, take a canoe and nature trail excursion through the rain forest or a wilderness exploration followed by a sumptuous crab feast you'll long remember (not included).

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required



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to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Vancouver:

September is one of Vancouver's best month's temperature-wise hopefully producing mild and clear skies. Average daytime temperature in September ranges from 15°C to 18°C. In a city that is famous for its rain, September is not the rainiest by far. You can expect about eight days, or about one-quarter of the month, to be rainy.

Canmore:

The climate in Canmore is cold and temperate due to its elevation (1400m). There is significant rainfall throughout the year in Banff, even the driest month still has a lot of rainfall. Summer temperatures are the warmest month and are pleasant with an average high of 21.6 °C and an average low of 7.3 °C. Snow has been recorded in all months of the year.

Alaska:

Alaska's Inside Passage region has a temperate summer climate. Dry in early summer, with slightly more rain likely from August onward, temperatures average between 4 °C and 20 °C. The weather is changeable. Expect long days of sunlight.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the Airline directly with seating

allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the Airline once you have your flight information.

Passport Validity:

Customers are required to provide valid passport details either at the time of purchase, or no later than 45 days prior to departure date. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the booking. In this instance customers will be responsible for any costs and fees incurred.

CRUISE

Disembarkation:

- Begins approximately 2 hours after docking.
- Due to security reasons, all guests must be on board 2 hours before sailing.
- Itineraries are subject to change at any time without notice.
- Check your specific sailing for exact departure and arrival times. All times are local to the port.

Cruise Loyalty Discounts:

Please note: Travellers booked via TripADeal will not be entitled to receive any cruise line customer loyalty discounts. Similar to airline frequent flyer programs, this is outside of the TripADeal booking process. However, customers may contact the cruise line direct upon receiving their TripADeal travel documents to request any membership benefits they are entitled to.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and off-loading of the luggage from the coach.

Gratuities (tips) are not included in the tour price for services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip for the tour leader and driver is \$10 AUD per person per day, which will be collected whilst on tour. For the cruise, the prepaid gratuities are included in the package. However any additional extras purchased on board will have a gratuity of up to 18% added.

Sightseeing:

Please note: In the event entrance to a site is affected by changes in operating hours or public holiday closures, your itinerary will be adjusted to ensure you do not miss out on the experience.

Shopping:

Shopping overseas can be a daunting and confusing experience, especially when there is a language barrier. Please be very cautious when foreign currencies and prices are involved. If paying by credit card, please pay close attention to the amount you are being charged and keep all of your receipts.

VISAS

An ESTA (Visa Waiver) for the USA is a strict requirement when travelling to or flying through the USA. Once a USA ESTA Visa Waiver is issued it is valid for 2 years or until your passport expires (whichever is sooner) and will allow multiple entries into the USA. For
