# THE ITINERARY

#### Day 1 Australia - Buenos Aires, Argentina

Today depart from Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane Adelaide or \*Perth for Buenos Aires, Argentina. Fly with LATAM Airlines, Qantas Airways, Air New Zealand and any codeshare partners (subject to availability). Upon arrival into Buenos Aires, be welcomed by a tour representative and transferred to your hotel.

Overnight: Hotel Grand Brizo or similar, Buenos Aires,

Day 2 Buenos Aires City Tour & Tango Dinner

Today is a chance to really experience the magic of Buenos Aires! Following breakfast, enjoy a three-hour city bus tour to see the beautiful parks and gardens of the Recoleta and Palermo neighbourhoods, the Colon Theatre, Mayo Square, The Cathedral, traditional Mayo Avenue, Congress Square and many other buildings and palaces (entrances not included).

The tour continues with a visit to San Telmo, the residence of the aristocracy until the end of the 19th century. Afterwards you will have the opportunity to explore Caminito Street in La Boca - a street museum and traditional alley known for its brightly coloured houses. The tour bus will drop you in central Buenos Aires, where you may enjoy an afternoon exploring this vibrant city at leisure, or transfer to your hotel (transfer not included).

Around 8pm this evening you will be collected from your hotel and transferred to a Tanguería (Tango House) in the historic San Telmo neighbourhood, birthplace of tango and one of the oldest barrios (neighbourhoods) of Buenos Aires. Arrive at a Conventillo, a historic tenement restored and now a restaurant/ theatre, where La Ventana takes place. Kick off the night with a delicious three-course dinner and enjoy live tango and folk bands, a gaucho demonstration and a moving tribute to Eva Perón. After the show, you will be transferred back to your hotel around midnight.

### **Day 3 Buenos Aires Free Day**

Today enjoy a free day to explore this vibrant city at leisure, or alternatively take part in a day tour to Colonia, Uruguay (not included).

Optional Activity - Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay Day Tour - \$180 per person

Today discover the UNESCO-listed Uruguayan town of Colonia del Sacramento on a day trip from Buenos Aires. Leave the cosmopolitan capital behind for the slower pace of life on the other side of the Rio de la Plata. After a ferry ride (approx. 1 hour), meet a local guide for a walking tour of Colonia. Pause for a meal at your choice of restaurant (not included), then spend the afternoon at leisure discovering Colonia on your own at leisure. Return to Buenos Aires by ferry at the end of the day.

into the Iguazu National Park (Argentinian side) to spend the day exploring the falls and the surrounding rivers and jungle. The park consists of various trails that take you through the jungle onto wooden walkways built a few metres above the jungle floor and waterways. These raised platforms protect the natural habitat of the jungle wildlife and will give you some spectacular views.

Enjoy lunch at one of the restaurants in the park (not included) or bring a packed lunch with you from Puerto Iguazu to enjoy in the great outdoors. Return to Puerto Iguazu in the afternoon.

# Day 6 Iguazu Falls (Brazilian Side) - Rio de Janeiro

After breakfast this morning you will be met at your hotel and transferred to the Brazilian side of the Iguazu National Park. Enjoy a half-day guided tour of the the Iguazu River Canyon, the Salto Rivadavia, Three Musketeers and the Devil's Throat among other iconic landmarks on this side of the national park. This wonderful setting is further enhanced by the somewhat permanent formation of rainbows that are generated by the spray form the waterfalls.

Enjoy lunch at one of the park's restaurants (not included) and then transfer onwards to the airport in Foz de Iguazu (Brazil) for your connecting flight to Rio de Janeiro (approx. 2 hours). Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

Overnight: B&B Hotel Copacabana Forte or similar, Rio De Janeiro

### Day 7 Half Day City Tour & Sugarloaf Mountain

After breakfast you will be picked up from your hotel for a visit to downtown Rio de Janeiro. Visit the Sambadrome, Praca XV, Cinelandia, Maracana Stadium and the Metropolitan Cathedral (entrances not included). Continue onwards to

Sugarloaf Mountain ascending by cable car where you can enjoy the amazing views from the top of the famous mountain, including the iconic Christ the Redeemer statue in the distance. Afterwards, return to the hotel for an evening at leisure.

Embark on a boat ride (approx. 4 hours) through the beautiful Lagoa Azul and Praia de Araça located on the Ilha Grande. Enjoy lunch on the boat whilst anchored in a beautiful bay (drinks not included). Return to port and transfer back to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

# Day 10 Santiago Half Day City Tour

Departing from your hotel this morning you will begin the journey towards the centre of Santiago city. During the tour enjoy a panoramic view of the Barrio Bellavista, recognised for its strong bohemian style, along with a visit to the Central Market, a nineteenth century building with more than 214 shops, where you can try delicious traditional dishes. The tour continues to the Mapocho Station, a cultural centre converted in the 90s. Also visit The Museum of Fine Arts (entrance fee not included), one of the main centres of visual arts in Chile, founded in 1880. Next, enjoy a guided tour of the Cerro Santa Lucia, an urban park located in the heart of the city of Santiago, before visiting the Plaza de Armas, where you can see the Cathedral of Santiago, the town hall, the Central Post Office and the National History Museum. Continue your tour with a view of the former National Congress and "La Moneda"; the Palace of Government of Chile. Finally, enjoy a scenic drive through the modern part of Santiago and reach the store Faba, specialising in making jewellery with Lapis stone that you can only can find in Chile and Afghanistan. Return to your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

# **TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER**

#### **Tour Guide:**

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

#### **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

### **CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES**

#### **Buenos Aires:**

Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina, has a temperate climate, which is classified as a humid subtropical climate under the Köppen climate classification with four distinct seasons. Summers are hot and humid with frequent thunderstorms while winters are cool and drier with frosts that occurs on average twice per year. Spring and fall are transition seasons characterised by changeable weather.

# Puerto Iguazu:

Puerto Iguazú has a humid subtropical climate. Temperatures are warm in winter and hot in summer. There is no dry season and rainfall is abundant with every month receiving over 100mm of rain.

#### Rio de Janeiro:

Rio has a tropical savanna climate that closely borders a tropical monsoon climate according to the Köppen climate classification, and is often characterised by long periods of heavy rain between December and March. In inland areas of the city, temperatures above 40 °C are common during the summer, though rarely for long periods, while maximum temperatures above 27 °C can occur on a monthly basis.

#### Santiago:

Santiago has a cool semi-arid climate, with Mediterranean patterns: warm dry summers (November to March) with temperatures reaching up to 35 °C (95 °F) on the hottest days; winters (June to August) are cool and humid, with cool to cold mornings; typical daily maximum temperatures of 14 °C (57 °F), and low temperatures near 0 °C (32 °F). The precipitation average is 312 mm.

# **FLIGHTS**

# **Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:**

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow preselected seats. We strongly suggest you





contact the Airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the Airline once you have your flight information.

#### **Passport Validity:**

Customers are required to provide valid passport details either at the time of purchase, or no later than 45 days prior to departure date. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the booking. In this instance customers will be responsible for any costs and fees incurred.

### **COACH TOUR**

#### Meals:

Daily breakfast is included in the tour, for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. It is your responsibility to notify TripADeal of any dietary requests/requirements. Please note: we will do our best to meet your requests/requirements, however cannot guarantee that we will always be able to.

### Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and off-loading of the luggage from the coach.

#### **VISAS**

#### Brazil

As of 17th June 2019, Australian citizens wishing to visit Brazil will no longer need to apply or pay for a visa. They will be able to stay in Brazil for 90 days from the date of first entry in the country, extendable for an equal period, provided that it does not exceed one hundred and eighty days, every twelve months, counted from the date of the first entry into the Country.

# **Argentina**

A tourist visa for Argentina is no longer required if travelling on an Australian

Passport. Passengers must hold a passport valid at least six months on entry with one blank visa page. More information can be found at https://visasdirect.com.au/requirements

#### Chile

Australian passpot holders visiting Chile for tourism for 90 days or less, will now receive a tourist card on arrival. You must keep the card and present it to immigration officials prior to departure. The Chilean Government has removed the Reciprocity Fee for Australian travellers.

# Uruguay (applicable for customers purchasing optional colonial day tour only)

Australian tourists are eligible to enter Uruguay without a visa for visits up to 90 days. Visa and other entry and exit conditions (such as currency, customs and quarantine regulations) can change at short notice. Contact the nearest Embassy or Consulate of Uruguay for the most up-to-date information. http://protocol.dfat.gov.au/Mission/view.rails?id=213

Important: Please start arranging your visa at least 3 weeks prior to departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such a journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.
