is surrounded by majestic mountains and is perfect for both mountaineering and skiing. From the end of May to the end of July you can experience the midnight sun. Modern Narvik was the first industrial town in Northern Norway. It was given town status in 1902 when the Ofoten Railway was completed to haul iron ore from Kiruna in Sweden to the ice-free port of Narvik. The town became the focus of the world's attention in 1940 with the Battles of Narvik occurred and the history can be explored at the Nordland Red Cross War Memorial Museum (entrance not included). The cable car on Narvikfjellet Mountain opens up an incredible bird's eye view of the town and dramatic landscape around Ofotfjord.

Day 11 Longyearbyen, Svalbard, Norway – 7:00am to 7:00pm

Located midway between continental Norway and North Pole is Svalbard. Where the extraordinary is ordinary, Longyearbyen, the administrative centre of Svalbard, is a tiny Norwegian metropolis with 2,100 residents from almost 50 different countries. The small Arctic town is inhabited by nature enthusiasts who live in close unity under tough climatic conditions with the High Arctic wilderness right on their doorstep. Longyearbyen is the gateway to the nature-based experiences and the starting point for most adventures in Svalbard. Keep an eye out for polar bears as they have been spotted in this area.

Day 12 Barentsburg, Svalbard, Norway – 1:00pm to 8:00pm

Spend the morning cruising towards Barentsburg for an afternoon arrival. Located 55km from Longyearbyen, Barentsburg is the second-biggest settlement on Svalbard, with a little under 500 inhabitants. The village was named after the famous Dutch explorer Willem Barentsz and is mainly inhabited by Russian and Ukrainian coal miners and their families. The village was originally founded by a Dutch mining company in the 1920s - hence the name. Though only a small village, you can find a bar, brewery, a hotel and restaurant, and even Russia's northernmost embassy.

Day 14 Honningsvåg, North Cape, Norway – 4:00pm - 2:00am

Today cruise towards Honningsvåg for a night time arrival. Though Norwegian law states that a city in Norway must have 5,000 inhabitants, tiny Honningsvåg, a community of around 2,500, is one of the smallest cities in Norway having been granted this status in 1996. The 'city' lies on the south-eastern side of a large island called Magerøya in the Barents Sea. It is the starting point of excursions to the dramatic North Cape where from a high plateau the monumental 307-metre high cliff plunges into the ocean. From here only endless ocean lies between the northernmost point of Europe and the North Pole. Witness the midnight sun, where the sun is hovering on

the horizon all night long (Depending on weather conditions).

Buildings with turrets and towers and facades with medieval romantic ornaments add a quirky charm to the town that is considered to be the most beautiful in the country. From the park 418 steps lead to the summit of Mount Aksla, which affords wonderful views of Alesund.

This morning cruise Boknafjord which lies between the cities of Stavanger and Haugesund as you make your way to Stavanger. Stavanger is surrounded by beautiful fjords, mountains, and long, white beaches. It is a vibrant, modern city with Gamle Stavanger at its core. The picturesque old

part of Stavanger has gently sloping cobbled streets lined with small, white wooden houses built at the end of the 18th and early 19th centuries. The city’s Anglo-Norman style cathedral was built in 1125, the same year Stavanger was officially founded. One of the most popular excursions from Norway’s fourth largest city is a visit to the Iron Age Farm at Ullanhaug giving a fascinating insight into life in the area some 1,500 years ago (not included).

Please note: Inside cabins are all twin beds that cannot be converted to king/queen. Ocean View rooms offer twin / double with unobstructed views.

Marco Polo is an extremely comfortable ocean liner with a wide range of public areas and deck spaces in which to relax. However, it is your cabin that should be the perfect place to unwind after a busy day sightseeing ashore and your unobtrusive cabin steward will ensure that you enjoy a high degree of comfort and service, whichever grade of accommodation you decide best suits your holiday requirements.

They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

London

June is a popular time to visit London, UK, as the weather is steadily getting warmer throughout the month. During this time of year the average temperature is 16°C.

Fjords and Arctic

The best time to visit Norway is Jun-Aug promise long days and the fabled midnight sun ideal for hiking, cycling or cruising – but no guarantee of heat, even if it won't be cold! The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Ålesund in June is 10°C. As June arrives, Svalbard is well and truly into the 'polar day' season with 24 hours of daylight and of course the midnight sun. Temperatures start to tip over 0°C (generally ranging between -1°C and 3°C).

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the Airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. VISAS

A tourist visa for Europe is not required for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian passport.

It is also important to note, some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.
