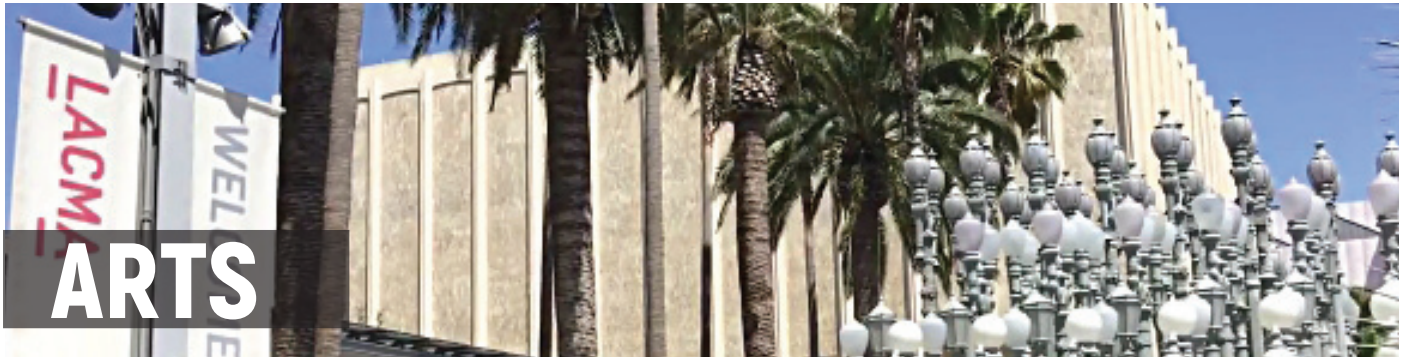

Established in 1905, Loma Linda University Health is a global leader in education, research and clinical care.

They offer more than 100 academic programs and provide quality health care to over 40 000 inpatient and 1.5 million outpatient visitors each year.

Loma Linda University is a Seventh-day Adventist organisation with more than 4400 students located in Southern California. Eight schools comprise the University organisation. We share our campus with six hospitals where students receive hands-on training. More than 100 programs are offered by the schools of Allied Health Professions, Behavioral Health, Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Public Health and Religion. U.S. News & World Report named La Sierra University the most diverse university in the western United States the past five years. And in early 2008 the Corporation for National and Community Service selected La Sierra for the Honor Roll with Distinction, part of the 2007 President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll program. The award recognized La Sierra's students for providing nearly 45 000 hours of service. Such efforts included international economic development projects by La Sierra's World Cup-winning Students In Free Enterprise team, and community projects through La Sierra's campus-wide Service-Learning program.

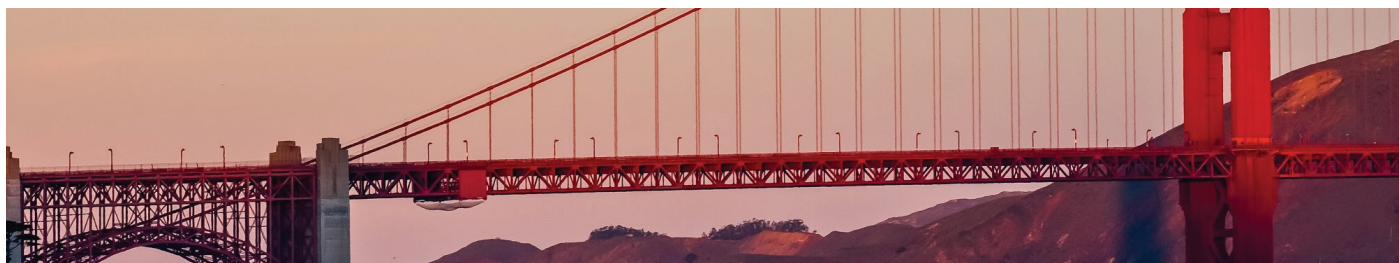

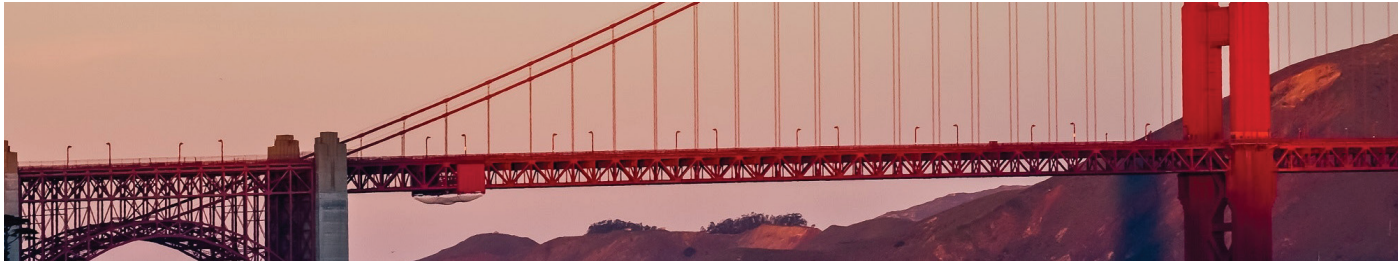

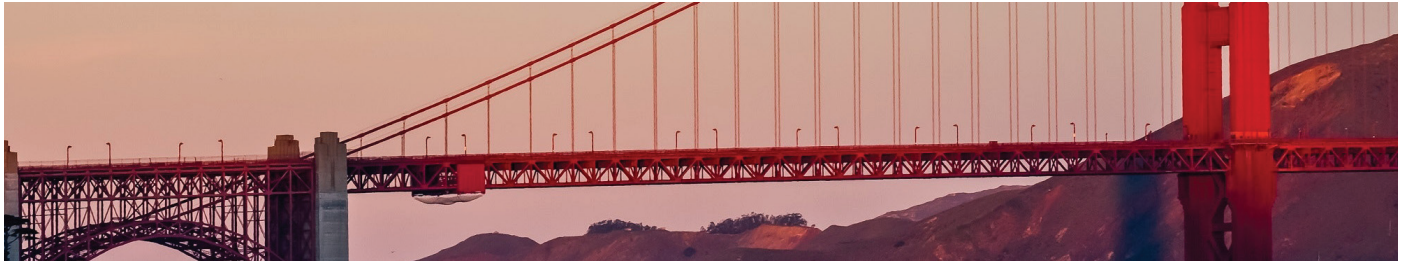
