Line Management: This position will be responsible to the Head of Senior School through the Head of Science Faculty and ultimately to the Principal.

Duties

- Plan, prepare and deliver the Chemistry and Biology curriculum (and other Science courses) to Senior School students and allowing for different learning styles and academic needs
- Work collaboratively with other members of the Senior School team
- Participate in curriculum development
- Take responsibility for a Pastoral Care class, including:
 - developing positive relationships with students
 - monitoring uniform, appearance and student behaviour
 - teach the Pastoral Care program
 - liaise with parents regarding academic and pastoral progress of students
 - undertake administrative tasks required
- Participate in professional development activities
- Liaise with students and parents
- Participate in the school's co-curricular program
- Support the Christian ethos of an Anglican School
- Other duties as required

Selection Criteria

- A relevant degree/qualification
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching Science and particularly Chemistry and Biology to Senior School students and the ability to teach other subjects, preferably Earth and Environmental Science and/or interdisciplinary STEM Courses.
- A passion for effective teaching and learning and for teaching Science, particularly Chemistry and Biology
- An interest in working with adolescents
- Open to interdisciplinary learning
- The ability to differentiate the teaching program to address students' learning styles and varied academic needs
- A willingness to participate in curriculum development and professional development
- Expertise or interest in the emotional, social and physical development of adolescents
- Experience in the meaningful integration of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) into the curriculum
- Skills in differentiation
- Experience in teaching students with special learning needs
- Be willing to contribute to the school's co-curricular program which may include sport or other activities
- Understanding of positive education
