Tuckshop can only exist if sufficient volunteer helpers are available. We welcome help from Mums, Dads, Grandparents, caregivers and friends, who can spare 2-4 hours per month. Help is required from 9am to 2pm each day the Tuckshop is open. Basic duties of food preparation and counter service are carried out in a casual, friendly environment. However if you do not feel comfortable in dealing with money or food preparation we can roster you on to something that suits you. The Tuckshop is also Centrelink friendly when it comes to those needing to volunteer for Newstart.
