







INCURSION 1: ABORIGINAL CULTURE INCURSION

Vacation Care will be having an incursion to learn more about Indigenous culture. Our visiting speaker is Paul Burragun.

Paul was born in Brisbane and now resides at Mudgeeraba, Gold Coast. Paul is a Bundjalung-Yugambeh descendant.

He visits schools sharing culture and delivering educational lessons such as art, music, stories, language, traditional games, artefacts displays, art works and demonstrations.

His background is that of a youth worker, health worker and tour guide.

Paul is an active and contributing member of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities in the region and founded the first ever all Aboriginal boomerang team named 'Deadly Returns'. He was on the Australian team at the World Boomerang Cup, Perth 2014.

We will be learning about:

- 1. Music: didgeridoo and clap stick lessons
- 2. Traditional Games: Tarakan and boomerang games
- 3. Weaving: local natural cotton wood fibre (wrist band)
- 4. Language: Aboriginal animal names
- 5. Artefacts display: hands on discussion
- 6. Ochre: on arms or face (traditional Aboriginal paint)
