What does ATO require?

The ATO guidelines of what the building fund money can be spent on stipulates that it –

- cannot be used for maintaining facilities which are not buildings including sports fields, sports equipment, playgrounds, landscaping and open-air car parks.
- cannot be used for buildings that are non-school buildings and other facilities that are not buildings.
- school building fund is solely providing money to acquire, construct or maintain the school building for the purposes of using that building as a school. It cannot be used for any other purpose.
