Dear Parents

I am extremely pleased to announce the trial of an additional 5:00pm intercampus bus shuttle service from Carbrook to Springwood, during Term 3 this year. The aim of this exciting initiative is to serve our College community by providing parents and students the convenience of a second after school bus shuttle between Carbrook and Springwood campus for students involved in after school co-curricular activities. The service will also provide an unsupervised drop-off at Logan Hyperdome, if required.

This service will be provided on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons at the small cost of \$2.00 per student per trip to assist with the sustainability of the new service. Students at the Carbrook campus returning to Springwood will need to finish their co-curricular activity at 4:45pm and go directly to the bus which will leave promptly at 5:00pm. It is expected to arrive at Springwood campus by 5:30pm where they will be supervised by the bus driver. Children must be collected promptly at 5:30pm. A delayed pickup may require qttendance ay the College Outside School Hours care service and an associated fee will be incurred.

Middle and Senior School Siblings remaining at Carbrook campus, who are not participating in cocurricular activities, will be required to go to the Library for supervised homework until 4:45pm. Junior School students remaining at Springwood for older siblings to catch the bus must be booked in at OSHC.

The use of this service will require booking to ensure that the daily bus roll is up-to-date. Parents will have the option of booking their children up to 3:00pm each day and can nominate a regular booking. Parents are asked to email the following address – bus@calvarycc.qld.edu.au by 3:00pm each day to reserve the seat or make changes to bookings. This address will be added to the contacts tab of the College App.

We anticipate that the service will be popular. In response to parent feedback of the service, should this trial be successful, we will look at providing this service during Term 4 and 2016, and with possible extension of the service to students on both campuses in the future.

Our hope is that this service will assist busy families and allow students greater opportunity to be involved in co-curricular activities.
