SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Claremont College has a fine tradition and outstanding reputation in our community for the manner in which students dress and conduct themselves both at school, when representing the school on excursions, off-site activities, sports, and when in public (during and out of school hours). Children should always wear their uniforms proudly and parents, (as part of the enrolment contract), are expected to support the uniform requirements of the school. The uniform requirements of Claremont College are aligned with the following Core Value statements;

- *Providing a nurturing school community through care and respect for self, others and the environment.*
- *Honouring the rich history and heritage of Claremont College.*

- Formal hat to be worn to and from school, and to Monday morning assemblies. Sunhats are to be worn at recess and lunch. "No hat, no play". Hats can be purchased through the Clothing Pool.
- Shoes should be polished.
- Boys' socks to be pulled up.
- Boys' formal shirt to be tucked in and have ties done up correctly.
- Boy's optional Summer shirt with crest does not require a tie or need to be tucked in.
- Uniforms should fit correctly, be clean and tidy and be in a good state of repair (ie buttons sewn on - additional buttons available from Wylies, blazer cuffs correct length, tunic length just below the knee).
- Full uniform (including blazer in the winter) must be worn to and from school. If children go shopping after school, the full uniform must be worn.
- Summer uniform is worn from January until mid May (date announced each year) and during Term 4. Winter uniform is worn from mid May until the end of Term 3.
- Black school shoes from K to 2 can have velcro tabs or strap style.
- Blazers can be worn for warmth with the Summer uniform but are only compulsory to and from school with the Winter uniform.
- Jumpers are only worn for additional warmth under the blazer.
- Boys woollen vests may be worn for warmth with the Summer and Winter uniform and may be worn to and from school in summer and under blazer in Winter.
- Tracksuits must be worn to and from school on Wednesdays during Winter.
- Sports uniform to be worn on Wednesdays and on your child's PE class day.
- School bags and sports bags are used to carry all property to and from school. No other bags should be used. Stickers are not to be affixed to bags. One small key-ring can be attached to assist with identification. Bags include: Infants backpack, Primary backpack, Library/Excursion bag and Sports bag. All these bags can be purchased from Clothing Pool.

- The school badge, house badge and other special school badges may be worn. A plain watch may be worn. No other jewellery is acceptable.
- A yellow raincoat must always be carried in the school bag.
- A Claremont Art smock can be purchased from the Clothing Pool.
- Boys' hair must be cut in a conventional manner and must be above the collar. Defined layers, ridges and very short, shaved hair are not acceptable styles. Hair must not be allowed to fall across the eyes or touch the collar.
- Girls' hair must be short, plaited or tied back. Hair accessories may include green ribbons or a green headband only. Hair must not be allowed to fall across the eyes. 'Bali beads' and tight multiple braids and plaits are not permitted following vacations. Hair that can be put into a ponytail must be tied back.
- All items of clothing (including shoes and socks) must be clearly named with 'sew-on' labels. All other property must also be clearly named.
- Kindergarten and Year 1 girls are to wear the aprons to protect their tunic uniforms.
- All items may be purchased from Wylies at Maroubra with the exception of items marked 'Clothing Pool'.
- School and House badges are purchased from the school office and other items, from the Clothing Pool.
- Lost property is located outside the School Hall.
