a traineeship in Property Services (Agency) or Property Services (Real Estate). Entry requirements may vary, but employers generally require Year 10.

Employment opportunities for this occupation vary depending on the state of the real estate industry. The property market is very sensitive to the general state of the economy and factors such as government policy and interest rates. 

The Good Universities Guide

Thinking of entering tertiary education? Don't know where to start? The Support Centre contains all the information you will need to know about tertiary studies and what to expect, from what types of courses are available to what campus life is really like.

There's a lot of choice involved when you decide to pursue tertiary study, such as which course interests you and which study mode will best fit your lifestyle.

Each institution is unique and you can be certain that each will deliver your chosen course in a different way and with a distinctive flavour.

The type of institution you choose will depend largely on whether you want to study a higher education course or a Vocational Education and Training (VET) course, but it will also be influenced by the style in which you would like your course to be taught.

You will find that there is some overlap in the qualifications that each institution type offers. For instance, while universities are known for offering higher education degrees with an academic focus, some also offer VET qualifications through a TAFE department. Likewise, while TAFE institutes are traditionally the providers of VET certificates and diplomas, apprenticeships and traineeships, many are branching out to offer higher education degrees with a vocational emphasis. Private providers, on the other hand, may offer vocational education, higher education or a mix of both, and typically specialise in a particular field of study or ethos (a performing arts college or a Christian institution, for example).

The three types of tertiary institutions

- Universities
- TAFE institutes
- Private providers



While tertiary education certainly pays off in the long run, it can be difficult to part with your hard-earned dollars to pay (sometimes considerably high) tuition fees. As a student, you have more than your fair share of expenses — and it doesn't just stop at tuition fees. There are a range of study-related expenses to think about as well, including course equipment (such as laptops and textbooks) and maybe some extras, such as going on a student exchange. Accommodation costs may also take a significant chunk of your income, then there are utilities, groceries, car expenses, public transport, the odd faculty ball, and the list goes on.

There is help is available for eligible students in the form of loans, scholarships and government allowances.

Tax File Number

Any student will need a tax file number if he/she starts work (part-time and full-time) and all students planning on a tertiary education require one when they start.

Importantly, current Year 12 students are reminded that they will be requested to provide their Tax File Number (TFN) on enrolment to TAFE or university next year, so it is worthwhile getting an application submitted early!

Students must now apply for a TFN online and have their identity verified through an interview at a participating Australia Post office.

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The National Scholarship Program celebrates the talents and strengths of young people who exhibit extraordinary promise – but who lack the support and resources to fulfil their potential.

Every year over 20 young people throughout Australia are awarded Youth Off The Streets scholarships. They are granted up to \$6000 each to help them pursue further education and training – and work towards a positive future.

What does a scholarship recipient receive?

Recipients receive \$6,000 towards educational or training goals. Funds are paid as required over two years and can be used to pay for some course fees and support costs such as equipment, uniforms, textbooks and stationary.

Who can apply?

Students aged 16 to 21 inclusive as at 20 September on the year of nomination.

Citizens or permanent residents of Australia (evidence will be required).

Students with a clear need for financial assistance.

Students studying in Australia for the two year period of the program.

VIEWPOINT :

Careers in Information Technology

\Whenever you Google “Jobs Of The Future”, “Best Paying Jobs”, or “Jobs In Most Demand”, you’ll always find Information Technology, or jobs in computers.

The most in demand job anywhere is cybersecurity... protecting data from hackers, viruses, ransomware and many other cybercrimes that threaten our interconnected world. Cybersecurity is the body of technologies, processes and practices designed to protect networks, computers, programs and data from attack, damage or unauthorized access. In a computing context, security includes both cybersecurity and physical security.

The second most in demand job is Data Analyst. Data analysts translate numbers into plain English. Every business collects data, whether it's sales figures, market research, logistics, or transportation costs. A data analyst's job is to take that data and use it to help companies make better business decisions.

Information technology is not just about cybersecurity and data analysis. It encompasses many jobs in the computer sciences... mobile devices, gaming, digital marketing, hardware and software, coding, design, service support, website development and sales.. the choice is vast and all these careers are in-demand which makes them highly paid jobs, and jobs that are transferable. So, an IT person in the defence force, can work in health technologies (a massive growing industry), the banking sector or in communication.

The fact that these technologies use English as a base language creates the opportunity for global travel, or online consultancy.

In this digital age, the IT sector is never going to stop growing ... it will create many in demand jobs with job security, great salary, transferable skills, new inventions of Artificial Intelligence (AI), robotics, blockchain technology, cybercurrencies (Bitcoin) to name a few. This is an industry where you never stop learning; a lifetime of education and upskilling every two years.

What’s really good about IT is that its gender neutral, although currently male dominated (this will change!) and there’s a job for every level of expertise. You can enter with a degree, diploma or certificate.

I often hear the misconception that jobs in this sector require a university degree. This simply is not true of many key roles. In an industry that is focused on practical skills, it’s easy to see why the combination of competency-based outcomes and hands-on experience typically offered by VET courses is, in many cases, more useful than more academic university studies. In fact, in one of the most in demand roles, ICT Support Technician, around half the current employees are VET qualified.
