

Compulsory BYOT Program



Clayfield College is committed to enhancing student learning by integrating relevant technologies into teaching and learning experiences. Our strategic intentions identify the need to, 'integrate ICT (Information Communication Technology) and other technologies across the curriculum to enhance learning within and beyond the educational context.' We are doing this through our compulsory BYOT Program, through which students will access, communicate, collaborate, and create in their daily learning experiences. Students from Years 1-12, under the direction of their teacher, are required to bring a device to school.

What is BYOT?

BYOT stands for Bring Your Own Technology. It is an approach now being preferred in schools around the world, in which the technology that students already possess and use in their daily lives can be utilised in their educational environment to enhance their learning experiences.

The age of your child may determine the type of primary device required. A general guideline would be:

- Years 1-2 iPads
- Years 3-12 Tablets/Laptops

The use of secondary devices such as iPods or Smart Phones may have their place in some lessons; however, this would be at the teachers' discretion and under teachers' instruction.

Why BYOT?

Clayfield College believes that controlled, appropriate use of technologies will help our students to become:

- Information producers rather than consumers
- Self-directed learners and collaborative team players.

We believe it is important to guide young people in developing the skills they will need to be productive, responsible digital citizens.

What are the Technical Requirements for BYOT?

All technology devices must have antivirus software to operate on the College environment. Any free antivirus would be sufficient for basic protection.

Recommended minimum technical specifications for the primary devices include:

- iPads with WiFi (no 3G or 4G capability required)
- Laptops – 8GB RAM, 250GB HDD/256GB SSD, WiFi, Windows 10 Professional, 64bit Version
- MS Surface Pro 4/5 – Intel i5 Processor, 8Gb of RAM, 250GB HDD, WiFi, Windows 10 Professional, 64bit Version
- Tablets – 1.0 GHz Processor, 16GB HDD, WiFi
- MacBooks – 8GB RAM, 250GB HDD/256GB SSD, WiFi, MAC OS X version 10.6 or later.

Wifi Requirements Recommended and Preferred

WiFi with 2.4 or 5 GHz on 802.11n or 802.11ac. All devices will have the technical features mentioned in their brochure or hardware specifications.

How does BYOT Work?

Students are required to bring their own technology devices into the classroom.

Under teacher direction, students are able to access our filtered WiFi Internet through BYOT Wireless and the VMWARE VIEW Horizon App where they are able to work virtually on the Clayfield SOE (Standard Operating Environment) at school and from home.

For those parents who wish to update their child's current device, Clayfield College has sourced bulk buying support from Datacom. Parents have the opportunity to purchase and choose from a variety of devices at discounted prices.

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Student Software

All students have access to Office 365 online, which enables use of all the Office applications online and/or install MS Office 2016 (both for Windows and MAC) to 5 devices.

Students can login via My Clayfield on the Clayfield College website, using their school email address with no password for the initial login, and student number and password for the subsequent login.

Students have access to One-Drive cloud storage (1000GB) Students in Years 7-12 can install Adobe Creative Cloud Design and Web Premium (limited applications) at no charge, or they can purchase a 12 month license for \$22, to the Adobe CC Master Collection (including Premier Pro, After Effects and extra apps). The license fee can be paid online via the Clayfield College website www.clayfield.qld.edu.au by going to Pay Online and selecting College Tours – Excursions & Activities – Adobe Suite Software Purchase and complete the relevant fields.
