- **Full Boarding** is all-inclusive permanent boarding from the start to the end of each term.
- **Weekly Boarding** is accommodation in the boarding house from Sunday night to Friday afternoon Laundry is not included but can be added for an additional \$498.75 per term.
- **Casual Boarding** is available for students who require accommodation for a day or more and may be utilised by day students when required. Please contact the Business Office to apply.

The Boarding Bond is charged per student and is only payable by families of boarding students. The Boarding Bond is refunded to the family on the basis that charges and damage, if any, relating to the Boarding House are satisfied. This applies to Full, Weekly and Casual Boarders.
