



Secondary Student Computer Acceptance Form - 2019

A. General

- This agreement begins on the date this form is signed and terminates on the final day of school in 2019.
- The cost of the ICT Levy is in accordance with the school's published fee schedule. This includes the costs associated with the device, ICT support, installed software as well as the general technology levy.

B. School's (Darling Downs Christian School) Level of Service Responsibilities

- The school will support the user and the computer within its warranty at the specified support times within school hours.
Note: Insurance does not cover intentional damage of the device and loss of accessories (bags, chargers and stylus).
- The school is committed to providing a safe environment for the use of ICT. Web browsing is logged and filtered using CyberHound.

C. Parents'/Caregivers' Responsibilities

- Parents have the full right and responsibility to manage the care and use of the device outside of school.
- Parents have the responsibility to ensure a level of cyber safety for the use of the device outside of school. For example: always keeping and using the device in a common area, disabling internet access when not specifically needed, setting time restrictions for daily use.
- Parents are responsible for any additional costs not covered by the warranty. Please note that there may be an **excess of \$60.50** for accidental insurance claims.
