

# COLLEGE UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

## Prep-10

The appropriate full school uniform is to be worn to and from school each day.

### Formal Uniform Compulsory Items

- College blazer to be worn to and from school (compulsory Years 5-10)
- College jumper (compulsory Prep – Year 4 & optional for Years 5–10)
- College white shirt
- College tie
  - Boys: Traditional tie to be worn at an appropriate torso length
  - Girls: Tartan bow tie
- **Boys:** College grey issue trousers (worn with short dark grey or black socks)  
**OR**  
College grey issue shorts (worn with light grey walking socks for Years 7-10 and short dark grey socks for Prep-Year 6)
- **Girls:** College tartan skirt (skirt length to be knee level, worn with short plain white socks, not anklet socks or black non-patterned stockings, 70 denier thickness)
- Black leather lace-up school shoes
- College backpack

### Optional Items

- College spray jacket to be worn over the jumper, blazer or rugby top but not in place of these (jackets must not be worn in the classroom)
- Girls College tartan trousers and shorts (Prep – Year 6 only)
- Black scarf and gloves
- College bucket hat (compulsory for K-6 and must be worn while at recess and lunch or as indicated by the teacher (e.g.: sports, excursions), in Terms 1 and 4.

## Kindergarten Uniform and Sports Uniform Prep-10

- College rugby top
- College polo top
- College white sports socks (plain white socks, not anklets, are permitted with no visible logo 7-10)
- College track pants
- College unisex black shorts
- Sensible sports shoes, predominantly white (no Dunlop Volleys or skate shoes)

## Additional Uniform Requirements

Full formal school uniform is to be worn to and from school each day with the following exceptions:

- Full sports uniform (rugby top, polo top, track pants and black shorts) is worn to and from school on:
  - PE days only (not for training)
  - A day where a specific instruction is given by the school in writing (e.g. excursion, special feast day)
- Blazers and jumpers may be removed and carried home if it is judged to be too hot. Students in Prep – Year 6 will be informed over the PA system during the day and an 'on/off sign' will be displayed in the 7-10 Office.
- On a day where the predicted temperature is 28 degrees or over, students may go to and from school without wearing their blazer and tie and College black shorts may be worn instead of track pants (when sports uniform is required as per days mentioned above).
- All ribbons and hair ties must be maroon, gold or black.
- College back packs are not to be decorated, but must have the student's name written within.
- Please clearly name every item of clothing.
- Girls are required to wear one piece bathers (no bikinis) while participating in any College water activity. i.e. Swimming Carnival, PE and Outdoor Education.
- When representing the College for swimming carnivals, students are required to wear the College black bathers. Plain black bathers with no visible logo can also be worn (one piece for girls).
- To maintain a neat appearance, parents are encouraged to dry clean their child's College blazers regularly.
