

CODE OF PERSONAL APPEARANCE

The Code of Personal Appearance requires students to accept that they are at school to learn and that they have a collective responsibility for the public image of the College. Where students are perceived to be in violation of this code, they will be required to amend their appearance. Students are expected to wear the College uniform with pride and maintain a clean and neat appearance at all times.

Hair

- Students are to have well groomed hair. Extreme styles are not acceptable. eg. Incuts, undercuts and 'rat's tails'
- No dyes, bleaches, tips and other additives are permitted.
- Students hair:
 - must not obscure eyes
 - if short, must be no less than No. 3 cutters on top and No. 1 on the sides (shall not be undercut).
 - must be tied back if longer than collar length (girls and boys)
- Boys must be clean shaven.

Jewellery

- One simple stud or sleeper (with no gem stones) is permitted in the lobe of each ear only.
- Jewellery in other piercings is not permitted to be worn.
- Necklaces, bangles, bracelets and rings are not permitted.
- A plain watch is permitted.

Cosmetics

- Students are not permitted to wear cosmetics, nail polish or false nails.
- Tattoos are not allowed.
- Students are encouraged to bring deodorant – roll-on only.
