Dear Parents/Guardians

We are now entering an important time of preparation for the future pathways of students in Years 7-9. In Years 8-10 students at Dominic College are able to select electives of their choice. This allows students to specialise in subject areas which may interest them.

The Academic Pathways evening is an important process for choosing electives. The Academic Pathways evening will be held on Tuesday 25 August at the Savio Centre from 6.30 – 8.00 pm. Students and parents will have the opportunity to speak to teachers about the elective subjects and receive advice about future career pathways.

We use an online Web Preferences Manager, which will allow students to make their elective choices online. Students will receive specific instructions via their student email on Monday 24 August. The Web Preferences Manager can be accessed following the Academic Pathways evening until Wednesday 2 September. Elective choices must be submitted by this date so that we can begin planning for timetabling of classes for 2016.

We would encourage parents and guardians to discuss elective options with your children so as to ensure they are choosing the best pathways for their future. Reserve choices must be carefully chosen as it may not be possible to guarantee that students will receive their initial preferences. Students must print their completed web preferences receipt, which must be signed by both the students and their parents before returning it to Pastoral teachers. Parents sign the preference form to show their consent for the chosen electives. Students are advised to print an additional copy for their own records.

I will be available to assist students in the library at lunch time each day from Thursday 27 August up until the submission date on Wednesday 2 September.
