The annual Prep-Year 6 **Swimming Campaign** will be conducted from **16-27 November 2015**. This year, once again, all classes will be going to the Aquatic Centre for one week as per the time-table below.

Students will be involved in activities to develop enjoyment, confidence and skills in swimming, water safety and survival techniques, provided by qualified swimming instructors at the Aquatic Centre. No money need be sent as this is covered by levies paid in your school fees. Watches and valuables (especially jewellery) should be left at home. Students are asked to wear their bathers to school under their sports uniform so they can start their lesson as soon as they arrive at the pool. Thongs or sandals are very useful to wear to the pool for quick changes and are recommended. Students will need a spare bag to take to the pool that has a towel, spare underwear, drink bottle, goggles (optional) and any other relevant items.

Because of our concern of the safety of your children it is necessary to take precautions. That is why we ask that you think carefully when you fill out medical information. We need to know if your child suffers from Asthma (medications needs to be in bag if this is the case), Diabetes or Epilepsy as we need to take extra care. It is for this reason that if your child has Epilepsy we need to have a **doctor's certificate** stating that the Epilepsy is controlled and it is okay for them to participate in these lessons.

Due to privacy laws no cameras or video equipment are allowed at the pool. Parent help, especially in the K-2 classes, may be required so please approach your son/daughters class teacher for discussions about this. Anyone offering parent help will need to have their up to date WWVP card.
