Requirements for acceptance into a Course	<p>Minimum level of English language proficiency The student's ability to meet minimum levels of English language proficiency would be established during the interview stage by the Principal or her designate.</p> <p>All Hallows' School will consider enrolment applications from students wishing to apply for a Student Visa, subject to compliance with minimum requirements and conditions set by the School, and with legislative requirements of the State of Queensland and the Commonwealth of Australia. This includes any requirements to undertake extra tuition to learn English to meet the English language proficiency standard needed to enter mainstream classes.</p> <p>Within the two courses offered, Junior Secondary (7-10) and Year 11 and 12 Senior Secondary Certificate of Education, the School can offer additional support services such as English as a Second or Additional Language for students who experience difficulties due to having English as a second or additional language. Such students are supported by an ESL Teacher. This support is provided through timetabled rotations in small group learning sessions. It includes developing literacy skills such as grammar, language features and understanding of genre requirements. The focus is on developing each student's ability to draft and edit her own work.
