STUDENT BOND

The student bond is a refundable deposit that will be returned in full if the following conditions are met:

- Student completes the full term of enrolment as per signed agreement or gives one terms notice.
- Student returns locker padlock and has cleared their locker.
- All textbooks are returned in same as condition.
- Students return their hired computer device in same as condition.

Failure to meet any of the conditions above may result in the partial or full forfeit of the deposit.

TUITION FEE & LEVY

The compulsory tuition fee and levies above covers all compulsory activities including ESL lessons, textbook hire, locker hire, student ID cards, technology levy (includes One2One Device for students in Years 7-12), excursions, transport to excursions and sporting activities, camps and events for Years 4-12 and P&F and Capital levy.

ORIENTATION WEEK

As part of the International students program, new students are required to attend the orientation week prior to commencing their enrolment.

The orientation week will cover important information related to the student's enrolment.

UNIFORM

Like all Australian schools, the College has a uniform that all students are required to wear appropriately. Students will be assisted to purchase their uniform during their orientation program.

HOMESTAY

The College can provide homestay and welfare for Year 7 - 12 students. All homestay payments must be paid before students can move into their homestay accommodation. Students not using the College International Homestay Program are required to stay with their parents or a biological relative.

The cost of homestay covers meals, accommodation, transport to and from school and some general transport. Homestay relocation fee is only required if a student requests a change in homestay without approved cause.

COMMUNITY EVENTS & CELEBRATIONS

Long-term international students are expected to attend main College community events and celebrations. These events may include sports carnivals; performances; College-organised social events and celebrations. The College will cover the cost of main College social events.

COLLEGE FEES & REFUND POLICY

Full fees need to be paid by due date and before the commencement of any enrolment, as detailed in the Letter of Offer.

Failure to pay the College fees by the due date, a late fee of \$75 may be applied to the student's College account.
