Ipswich Grammar School celebrates academic excellence and we are committed to supporting families with sons who have demonstrated they have the potential to benefit from the academic and co-curriculum programs offered at IGS. Scholarships are awarded as partial tuition fee relief and are granted to students who can demonstrate their ability to make a significant contribution to the school.

The academic program is intellectually challenging and empowers young men to learn and grow. A supportive environment with a broad offering of subjects, structured literacy programs and enrichment activities assists students in productive learning. The curriculum is learner centred, collaboratively organised, flexibly structured, and well resourced. Through cross-curricular initiatives, structured reading strategies, writers' camps, literacy competitions, and workshops, boys become interested readers and confident and skilled communicators.

Students entering Year 7 in 2018 or 2019 are encouraged to apply for a Local Area Academic Scholarship.

The key criteria for awarding scholarships at Ipswich Grammar School are:

- Overall academic performance and future potential
- Diligence and application in academic studies
- Achievement and involvement in other areas of excellence such as performing arts, visual arts, sport, music, debating and other relevant areas
- A demonstrated sense of community
- Leadership abilities

Conditions

Academic scholarship holders are expected to maintain a high standard of academic achievement contribute positively and enthusiastically to school life.

Scholarships are reviewed annually and may be withdrawn if the Headmaster is not satisfied with the diligence or conduct of the holder.

Application Process

Applicants are asked to send copies of their last two school reports, most recent NAPLAN results and a short letter on why they would like to attend Ipswich Grammar School to enrolments@ipswichgrammar.com
