Other Fees and Charges

Enrolment Application Fee (<i>non-refundable</i>)	\$150 on application for admission
Enrolment Confirmation Fee (<i>non-refundable</i>)	\$750 payable within 14 days of receiving notification of placement offer. A signed Enrolment Contract must accompany the payment.
Capital Levy (<i>non tax deductible</i>)	\$52.50 per term/per family. This levy will directly support the capital works program of the School

TUITION FEE

Items included in Tuition Fee: Curriculum based levies, camps, excursions, and extra-curricular activity buses.

Items not included: Textbooks and stationery, uniforms, travel to and from school, non-curriculum excursions, private tutoring for music and sport, excess printing and photocopying charges, and representative team expenses.

No fee reduction is offered for delays in students returning to school, extended absences during term, school-based apprenticeships, reduced subjects or for not participating in particular activities.

OTHER FEES & CHARGES

Additional Student Expenses: Some additional student expenses may need to be charged if incurred. These include non-curriculum related expenses and boarders' medical expenses.

Chartered Bus Fares: Charged on fee accounts in Term 2 and Term 4. The cost of these buses varies depending which bus the student catches. Costs may be charged on a pro-rata basis (ie: change of address) however, this is dependent on the bus pass being returned and/or a new bus pass being obtained.

SIBLING ALLOWANCE

Per day student: \$250 for families with more than one son attending. Discount is applied in Term 3.

Per boarding student: \$300 for families with more than one son attending. Discount is applied in Term 3.

Ipswich Girls' Grammar School: The same allowances apply in Term 3 for a student who has a sibling attending IGGS.

SCHOOL FEE ACCOUNTS

Billing: One fee account is generated per family and fees are billed on a per term basis (4 terms per annum)

Due date: Friday of the first week of each term.

Prompt Payment Discount: A Prompt Payment Discount of \$40 per student, per term applies if the full term payment is received by the due date.

Annual Payment Discount: A 5% discount applies if the annual fees for the family are paid prior to Friday of the first week of the school year.

Payment methods: Cash, cheque, credit card, EFTPOS, Bpay, EFT, Direct Deposit and online via the Ipswich Grammar School website.
