Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation Scholarships (Years 10 to 12) for 2019

The Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation is proud to offer 10 scholarships to allow new students the opportunity to join the Immanuel community. These students will benefit from the College's outstanding academic, pastoral and extra-curricular programs for the final three years of their schooling.

At Immanuel, we value a well-rounded education and are committed to nurturing our students by awarding scholarships across a broad range of academic and extra curricular areas.

The scholarships offer 50% remission on tuition fees (application and enrolment confirmation fees are also waived) equating to more than \$16,000 over three years.

To Apply: Candidates must complete an application form available on the College website:

Attach copies of:

1. Academic reports for Semester One & Semester Two for the last two years.
2. NAPLAN results.
3. Any other supporting documentation/certificates.

Applications close on 1 October 2018.

Eligibility: Candidates must currently be in Year 9 entering Year 10 in 2019.

- Demonstrated academic achievement (*essential*)
- A commitment to study (*essential*)
- Leadership potential (*desirable*)
- Active involvement in any one or more of the following areas: Sport, Music and the Arts (*desirable*)
- Community or Cultural service, i.e., positive contribution to/within the community (*desirable*)

Tenure: This scholarship is offered for the duration of the recipient's enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College (Years 10 to 12). Scholarships are reviewed each semester and subject to continued scrutiny to ensure that the recipient is applying themselves to their studies and abiding by College policies.

Cost: No charge.

Process: Candidates will be shortlisted to attend an interview with the Principal/Head of Secondary School.

Notification of Results Candidates will be informed in writing of the outcome of their application.

Terms and Conditions

1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal and are subject to a quota which is determined by the Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation.
2. Scholarships are not available to overseas full fee paying students.
3. Candidates, if shortlisted, may be invited to have an interview with the Principal/Head of Secondary School and all offers will be made in writing.
4. Scholarships are awarded on the proviso that the student continues to meet the specific conditions set out in their written offer, participates to the best of their ability in College activities and adheres to the College's Code of Conduct.
5. Scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete their schooling at Immanuel Lutheran College.
6. Scholarship students' results/commitment to College events will be monitored every semester, to ensure they are meeting their obligations.
7. The scholarship is offered for the duration of the recipient's enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College.
8. Should a scholarship recipient fail to meet their scholarship obligations, counselling, followed by a letter of warning shall be issued for corrective action to be taken by the student. The student shall then have the following semester to meet their initial scholarship requirements. In the event of the student returning a second unsatisfactory semester review, the scholarship may be reduced or cancelled as determined by the Principal.
9. Successful candidates who are not current Immanuel students will not be required to pay an application fee or the confirmation of enrolment fee as part of their scholarship package.
10. The scholarship does not cover costs such the resources levy, uniform, books or music tuition fees.
11. All candidates, both successful and unsuccessful, will receive written notification in due course.
12. Immanuel Lutheran College will not enter into a dispute regarding the awarding of scholarships.
