Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation Scholarships (Years 10 or 11) for 2021

The Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation is proud to offer a number of scholarships to allow new students to join the Immanuel community. These students will benefit from the College's outstanding academic, pastoral and extra-curricular programs for their senior secondary school years.

At Immanuel, we believe the whole person is the whole point and are committed to nurturing our students by awarding scholarships across a broad range of academic and co-curricular areas.

The scholarships range between 50% to 100% remission on tuition fees and are subject to a means test.

To Apply: Candidates must complete an application form available on the College website:

Attach copies of:

1. Academic reports for Semester One & Semester Two for the last two years.
2. NAPLAN results.
3. Any other supporting documentation/certificates.

Applications close on 28 August 2020.

Eligibility: Candidates must either be in Year 10 in 2021 or Year 11 in 2021.

- Demonstrated academic achievement and/or application (*essential*)
- A commitment to study (*essential*)
- Leadership potential (*desirable*)
- Active involvement in any one or more of the following areas: Sport, Music and the Arts (*desirable*)
- Community or Cultural service, i.e., positive contribution to/within the community (*desirable*)

Tenure: This scholarship is offered for the duration of the recipient's enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College. Scholarships are reviewed each semester and subject to continued scrutiny to ensure that the recipient is applying themselves to their studies and abiding by College policies.

Application Fee: No charge.

Process: Candidates will be shortlisted to attend an interview with the Principal/Head of Secondary School.

Notification of Results Candidates will be informed in writing of the outcome of their application.

Terms and Conditions

1. Foundation Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal and are subject to a quota which is determined by the Immanuel Lutheran College Foundation.
2. Foundation Scholarships are not available to overseas full fee-paying students.
3. Foundation Scholarships are only offered to new students intending to enrol at Immanuel Lutheran College and will be subject to a means test.
4. Candidates, if shortlisted, may be invited to have an interview with the Principal/Head of Secondary School and all offers will be made in writing.
5. Foundation Scholarships are awarded on the proviso that the student continues to meet the specific conditions set out in their written offer, participates to the best of their ability in College activities and adheres to the College's Code of Conduct.
6. Foundation Scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete their schooling at Immanuel Lutheran College.
7. Foundation Scholarship students' results, commitment to studies and a high standard of behaviour will be monitored every semester, to ensure they are meeting their obligations.
8. The Foundation Scholarship is offered for the duration of the recipient's enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College.
9. Should a scholarship recipient fail to meet their scholarship obligations, counselling, followed by a letter of warning shall be issued for corrective action to be taken by the student. The student shall then have the following semester to meet their initial scholarship requirements. In the event of the student returning a second unsatisfactory semester review, the scholarship may be reduced or cancelled as determined by the Principal.
10. Successful candidates will not be required to pay the application or confirmation of enrolment fee as part of their scholarship package.
11. The Foundation Scholarship does not cover costs such the uniform, books or music tuition fees.
12. All candidates, both successful and unsuccessful, will receive written notification in due course.
13. Immanuel Lutheran College will not enter into a dispute regarding the awarding of scholarships.
