- Bus fare for 2019 is \$350 per term / \$1400 per year.
- Please be aware that there may be a waiting list for some bus routes.
- Children are required to be at the designated stop 5 MINUTES before pick up.
- Trips to after-school activities are not permitted eg. workplace, sport clubs, sleep overs etc
- Casual trips can be arranged when necessary at a cost of \$12 per day (depending on seating availability)
- Bookings for casual trips, or other changes, must be made by calling school reception, giving 24 hours' notice for travel the next day.
- A bus is provided for siblings at Reedy Creek Campus that leaves the Pimpama Campus at 7:20am and returns at approx. 4:40pm.

The buses are used exclusively by King's students so parents can be assured that the safety and supervision of their children is closely monitored. The buses provide busy parents with the convenience of transporting their children to and from school each day. Our network of routes covers most of the Gold Coast catering for students regardless of where they live - near or far.

These buses also provide the added bonus of ready and inexpensive transportation of our students to school excursions, performances, sporting competitions and carnivals.

### Daily Bus Routes

Bus #1	Pacific Pines Riverstone Crossing / Pimpama (west side of M1) via Oxenford, Coomera, Upper Coomera and Coomera Springs
Bus #2	Chirn Park / Pimpama (east side of M1) via Harbour Town, Runaway Bay, Coombabah, Hope Island, Coomera, Gainsborough Greens and Pimpama
Bus #3	Koorong Springwood / Daisy Hill / Cornubia / Eagleby / Edens Landing / Beenleigh / Mt Warren Park / Ormeau

### Pimpama - Reedy Creek Connection Bus

- For older siblings of Pimpama students there is a bus available from Pimpama Campus to the Reedy Creek Campus. Times and route as follows:

**MORNINGS:** Depart Pimpama Campus at 7.20am - arrival at Reedy Creek Campus approximately 8.20am

**ROUTE:** Pimpama Campus / Coomera / Hope Island Road (Homeworld) / Nerang / Reedy Creek Campus

**AFTERNOONS:** Depart Reedy Creek Campus at 3.30pm - arrival at Pimpama Campus approximately 4.40pm

**ROUTE:** Reedy Creek Campus / Nerang / Hope Island Road (Homeworld) / Coomera / Pimpama Campus
