CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, King's Christian College offers a limited number of scholarships for the start of the following academic year.

When will Scholarship Exams be held?

Scholarship exams are held each year in February and May. Scholarship candidates and their families are also invited to our Open Days. Please visit our website for specific dates.

Awarding of Scholarships

- All scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal.
- The conditions below are guidelines for the minimum expected standards to be considered for a scholarship offer.
- In order to maintain a scholarship, recipients must maintain minimum standards of behavior, academic results, involvement in College life and achievement in their scholarship area.
- Subject to meeting the conditions to maintain a scholarship, it is expected that the scholarship will remain in place until the student leaves King's Christian College upon graduating from Year 12. If the student leaves the College prior to graduating from Year 12,

the College may require repayment of scholarship benefits already awarded.

Principal's Scholarship

• Prestigious scholarship granted to a student at the Principal's discretion.

Academic Scholarships

- Scholarships of 100% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are generally available to those students whose results in the Scholarship exams are in the top 5% band.
- Scholarships of 50% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are generally available to those students whose results in the Scholarship exams are in the top 10% band.
- Scholarship exams are open to all students who will be in Years 4 11 in the following year.
- A \$20 fee is payable prior to sitting the exam.

CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Music Scholarships

• Music scholarships are available for selected instruments. To be eligible for a music scholarship, applicants must sit the academic scholarship exam as well as arrange for an audition. More information regarding the audition requirement is available from the College website.

Sporting Scholarships

• Sporting scholarships are awarded separately to academic scholarships. They may be awarded to students who achieve at a State level in a school sport. Sporting scholarships are assessed annually and awarded for the following year. For more information, please contact the Director of Sport.

REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS PLACED ON SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

In order to maintain a scholarship students must:

- demonstrate high standards(As or Bs) in relation to Application and Behaviour.
- demonstrate high standards of behaviour in the College community at all times.
- demonstrate a positive influence in the College community.
- demonstrate high standards in relation to attendance and uniform.

Academic Scholarship holders must achieve high standards in the end of semester reports (As or Bs for High School, VHA or AGL for Primary School).

Music Scholarship holders must continue studies in their chosen instrument/s, either through the College or privately, and will be actively involved in the College ensemble program. Participation in the ensemble program includes weekly practice rehearsals, as well as various performances that are held throughout the year.

Sporting Scholarship holders must:

- be involved in the College sporting team related to the scholarship.
- support the sporting events of the College.
- compete at State level each year in a school sport so that the scholarship may continue.

CANCELLATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A scholarship may be cancelled if:

- the recipient fails to maintain the high standards and expectations as set out above.
- the recipient is suspended or excluded from the College.
- the student leaves the College.
